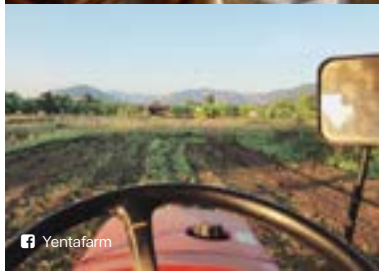

Day 1

Head to Doi Saket, home to **Chiang Mai Celadon**, the distinctive green celadon porcelain manufacturer that preserves traditional folk wisdom with a uniquely patterned porcelain surface. It has become a must-have GI product that can only be purchased in Chiang Mai. Continue to the **Tai Lue Muang Luang Nuea Community**, and put on a farmer's hat for the day. Consisting of a bamboo grove that yields sweet bamboo shoots, the community also houses a longan garden, a vegetable garden, and a Khaki Campbell duck house. These ducks typically lay large eggs with beautiful yolks. Help gather the

eggs to boil and scramble, eating them with young banana blossoms collected in the garden. Then pay a visit to **Suan Ban Yenta**, learning about new theories of agriculture in an orchard. Get to know the rice varieties that are native to Chiang Mai, then go back to the city's hip Nimmanhaemin Road for a break at **Flour Flour**, a small bakery that started making bread from cultivating natural yeast. Next, continue on to Hang Dong District, check-in in the middle of the rice fields and natural surroundings at **Phu Anna Eco House**. Be welcomed with Gymnema Tea, a famous OTOP product, while you relax in the beautiful setting.





Day 2

Wake up early for a bike ride to appreciate nature and take in the freshness of the community surrounding the resort. You can also learn about farming from the kind hosts; if you visit during the farming season, become a farmer and plant rice seedlings right in front of your accommodations. When lunch rolls around, go to **Ginger Farm Kitchen**, which cooks Lanna fusion food with local ingredients and vegetables from their own farm, served with

organic rice. With a full stomach, continue to learn about the source of ingredients as **Ginger Farm** also serves as a learning center for organic agriculture. Here, children can experiment with being a small farmer, learning about growing vegetables and rice farming. Before saying goodbye to Chiang Mai, don't miss out on shopping for provincial goodies at the Chiang Mai OTOP Exhibition and Distribution Center and **Mee Na Mee Khao** restaurant. The latter stands out with its



shaded atmosphere and carefully selected raw materials for healthy, safe consumption - after all, rice is more than just a staple, it's an important storyteller.

Wang Nam Khiao is unique in that it has a cool temperature all year round. In addition to model organic farms it is an agrotourism destination such as in Ban Suk Somboon Community, a tourism community which has taken the farmers' lifestyle and turned it into sustainable tourism.

Day 1

Travel to **Ban Suk Somboon Community** an agrotourism destination of Wang Nam Khiao which started with the intention to conserve the upstream Moon River and its rich natural resources. You are welcomed with healthy vegetable beverages before lunch by the community chefs featuring dishes such as **5 Star Korat Noodle**, a popular OTOP product of the province. Then enjoy the yams, corn, shitake mushrooms and chrysanthemums as well as organic vegetables and take a coffee break at **Wang Nam Khiao Coffee Roaster**, a famous roaster and coffee shop of Wang Nam Khiao. Dinner tonight is at **Kanona café** before checking into **Darakaya resort**.



Day 2

Taking pictures of the flower fields at **Chateau Chili & Laven De Brume** by Suk Somboon Community Enterprise who grow seasonal flowers such as lavender and sun hemp on a 30 rai plot of land. Head over to **Mister Mushroom**, an iconic mushroom farm in Wang Nam Khiao, then over to **Suan Lung Krai**, a famous organic vegetable farm. Enjoy the music by Lung Krai while being served **Khaoyai wines**, GI products of Khaoyai. Stop by at **Village Farm & Winery**, a famous vineyard with not only wines and grape juice but also accommodation and restaurant.

Kon Khlong Bang Pa Community, Ratchaburi

**A classroom for learning about new
developments in agriculture**



The Mae Khlong River lies at the heart of Ratchaburi's abundance. In addition to the popularity of its iconic floating market, Ratchaburi is gaining momentum among travelers who want to study new agricultural methods. Many farms and communities have begun to modernize their traditional farming methods, to accommodate tourism that allows them to learn while experimenting. For anyone looking for a farmstay in the middle of an orchard or farm, the choice destination would naturally be Ratchaburi.



Day 1

While traveling to Ratchaburi, before embarking on serious activities, you must shop for famous OTOP products at **Rai Mai Jone Sugarcane Juice Factory**. Then head to **Kon Khlong Bang Pa Community** or Suan Kowin, and take a boat to cruise around Bang Pa canal. Experience the natural surroundings of the orchards

lining the canal and enjoy the cool breezes. Then learn about the processing of produce and the various types of agricultural orchards of the community. Cycle through the orchards and take a lunch break with delightful dishes of **Ban Kha pineapple**. In the afternoon, try your hand at building an actual vegetable plot and join a workshop on processing dried bananas, a famous souvenir of the community. When finished, head to Amphawa in Samut Sakhon Province, and enjoy a meal in the garden atmosphere of **Greenery Cafe**. Check in and relax at **Asita Eco Resort**.

Day 2

Have an Ayurvedic relaxation massage, then have lunch. Then continue your orchard adventures in **Karanda Fruit, Lung Siri Orchard** that transforms mango and limes into delicious drinks and bakery items. And continue to **Aromatic Farm**, a photogenic coconut grove that offers a range of





delicious items made from chemical-free coconuts.

Day 3

Get into chill-out mode at the chic **Tanphawa Cafe**, a cafe in an Amphawa coconut plantation, and sample their signature coconut sugar coffee. While in Amphawa, you must not miss a visit to **Tao Tan Amphawa**



Chaipattananurak to see how coconut sugar is processed each step of the way. You can also walk around the coconut grove, finding cool angles and taking pictures for your social media. End the day with a Thai dinner in a riverside setting at **Ranjuan Amphawa**.

ARGOTOURISM

Route

Ban Phaya Bangsa Community, Satun

Enjoy tourism activities and learn about the way of life of a community that's abundant in nature, with fisheries and agriculture



Take a boat ride to see the elusive red eagles in Satun at Ban Phaya Bangsa, a community characterized by the abundance of natural resources and environmentally-conscious agriculture. One day in Phaya Bangsa is never enough. If you want to be satiated with the full experience, check into a homestay, gradually soaking in the simplicity and warmth of the community.



Day 1

Head to the Guden Mansion of the **Satun National Museum** to listen to stories about the history of Satun. Stop to try the famous roti and pulled tea. Continue with a visit to **Tammalang Village** and take a boat trip through the mangroves to see the rare red eagle, an indigenous animal. Local guides can whistle and summon hundreds of red eagles to fly around and show off their splendor. Have lunch on board the boat, then take a break at **Champada Organic Farmstay**.

Check out the special menu item of Champada cake, which uses a GI product from Satun as one of the raw materials, before continuing to **Thale Ban National Park**. Take a short hike on the nature trail and partake in bird-watching activities, featuring birds such as the white-bearded



swallow, striped bulbul, red-backed magpie, and woodpecker, while you sip refreshing melon juice. End the first day at the **Wang Prachan** border market of Thailand and Malaysia. Then check in at **Phayabangsa Resort** with a performance by community children as the evening highlight.

Continue downhill to **Phaya Bangsa Community** to learn local wisdom in farming through various learning-based activities such as beekeeping, organic fertilizer production, and mushroom cultivation. Take a break for lunch at **Krua Ban Sirada** then head to **Chimmelon Farm**, a melon farm with the star product of Satun Province, and visit the **Satun Champada Orchard** to learn about the

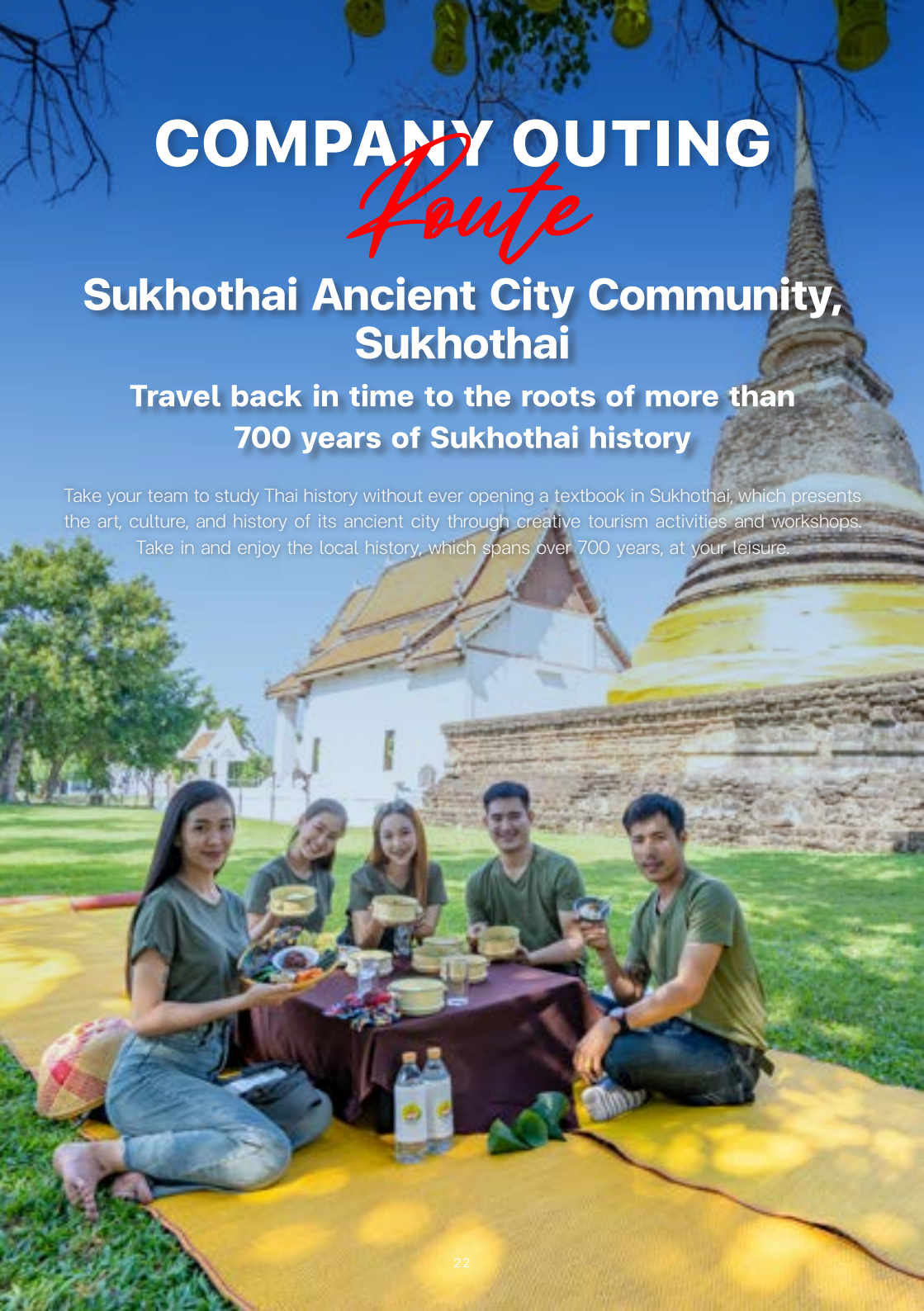

Sukhothai Ancient City Community, Sukhothai

**Travel back in time to the roots of more than
700 years of Sukhothai history**

Take your team to study Thai history without ever opening a textbook in Sukhothai, which presents the art, culture, and history of its ancient city through creative tourism activities and workshops.

Take in and enjoy the local history, which spans over 700 years, at your leisure.





Day 1

Begin the journey by paying respect to Phra Buddha Chinnarat at **Wat Phra Sri Rattana Mahathat** before arriving at **Ban Wang Som Sa Community**, Phitsanulok Province, a community that grows Som Sa, a rare fruit that is almost extinct. Be welcomed with local snacks and Som Sa tea while learning about the history of the community and learn to make herbal inhaler and learn how to concoct Bitter Orange (Som Sa) juice drink, before the lunch break of rice wrapped in lotus leaves, salads, and a variety of other non-toxic ingredients in the community. Shop for quality OTOP products before saying goodbye and making your way to the ancient city of Sukhothai. Pay homage at and see the beauty of **Wat Si Chum**, then retire to your accommodations for the night.

Day 2

Wake up early and get the team together to offer alms to monks on the Boon Klang Nam Bridge, **Wat Traphang Thong**. Then embark on sightseeing and



learning activities in **Muang Gao Sukhothai Community**. Keep a checklist of activity stations, such

as **Ban Preeda Phirom**, which stands out with its Sangkhalok designs on fabric, and learn about such patterns and their meanings. This is followed by a pottery-making activity where you can try out your own Sangkhalok designs at **Sangkhalok Art** before having a local-style lunch served in a tiffin. Enjoy the cool breeze at the isle in the middle of Wat Traphang Thong. Then start the afternoon activities at **Kanecha Gallery Studio**, where art fuses with the faith and history of Sukhothai to become **GI products like Sangkhalok**. Next, go to Laksamansilpa Imprinting House which will tell you the story of Sukhothai scriptures at Thailand's only imprinting museum. Try imprinting amulets using Sukhothai soil. In the evening, go for a bike ride or take a tram to see the historical route of the area, including famous temples such as **Wat Si Sawai** and **Wat Phra Sri Mahathat**.

Day 3

Shop for well known OTOP products such as auspicious **Khao Tok Phra Ruang stone ornaments at Baan Khao Tok Phra Ruang**, and visit **organic farming projects** and have lunch. In the afternoon, take part in a fun and relaxed competition to create works of art with the artists at **Rong Na Ban Rai**. The "Imaginary Giant" activity, for example, involves painting and making patterns on the masks

of literary characters while the "Thai-Thai book" activity has you making Thai patterned notebooks by hand. Before saying goodbye, make a special trip to **Street Art Sawankhalok**.

Turn waste into income and make Ban Amphur Community a green tourist destination for those who are interested in waste management. Add value and become part of what makes the beach in Chonburi cleaner and more attractive.



Day 1

Enjoy an outing in an atmosphere that promotes learning at **Ban Amphur Community**, which is outstanding for its comprehensive waste management efforts. Upon arriving, receive a welcome drink of fragrant coconut water to freshen up before continuing to Mae Foi Thong Shrine. Pay homage to the sacred items of the community that are over 115 years old, then walk to see the street art at the front of Ban Amphur Beach. Continue with the team building program, starting with Station 1: “Beautiful Beach with Our Hands” garbage collection competition and Station 2: “Valuable Waste”, where you will travel to Ban Amphur Waste Processing Plant to join a workshop that teaches you how to make bricks from

waste to reduce global warming. The bricks are then used to build a community school. Go on to Station 3: “TumTum YumYum” to learn about food ingredients and age-old recipes from a local expert such as fish chili paste.

Also, take part in a cooking competition using an **Ang Sila Stone Mortar**, a provincial GI product, as your main implement. Take a break for lunch at **Joi Ros Dee Restaurant**, a famous eatery in the community, and taste the



famous local dishes like grilled fish with chili fish sauce, papaya salad with savory rice and grilled fish, chili paste with fish and fresh vegetables, or rice mixed with fish chili paste, etc. At the end of the first day, go to your accommodations and enjoy some rest before changing clothes for the evening dinner party.

Tips Get your favorite swimwear ready because the sea of Chonburi is very beautiful.

Day 2

Arrive in Chonburi and pay homage to a large Buddha image carved with modern technology on the cliffs of **Khao Chee Chan**. Then go to **Silverlake Vineyard**, a famous winery amidst nature in Chonburi province. Next, continue to **Map Fak Thong Community**, where you can learn about the history of and be a part



of the community that protects the environment. Start doing fun team building activities at Station 1: making Phra Plai sweets from arrowroot flour, and Station 2: learning and competing in making containers from coconut. Then have lunch with a variety of organic vegetables on the menu and

seafood served by the community in a **Pikul Floral Pattern Bamboo Wicker Basket**, a provincial OTOP product. Wind down and bid farewell to the community. On the way back to Bangkok, don't miss a stop at **Ang Sila**, to shop for GI products like the Ang Sila Stone Mortar. Alternatively, stop at **the Bamboo Basketry Promotion Center** in Phanat Nikhom District of Chonburi, a production center and source of OTOP products for sale.

This comes with a welcome drink of fresh, sweet, and delicious coconut water from the organic coconut plantation in the community. Learn about the history of the community the origins of the forest in the sea, Khlong Roi Sai or “The Little Amazon”. Then start team building activities at Station 1: “Barman”, to learn about mixing drinks from natural ingredients like **Coconut Bird's Nest with Butterfly Pea**, which combines OTOP products, coconut, butterfly pea, local fruits, and herbs of the Leeled community together perfectly, or compete in cocktail making with Nasan Rambutan wine soda. At Station 2: “Must Savor the Deliciousness”, learn to make



Khanom Jak desserts or **Nasan rambutan shrimp paste**, both with raw materials of the province and community. Take a break and eat local, seasonal food prepared by skilled community chefs. Continue with Station 3: “Directional Signs” to create signs that help boat drivers to not get lost. Because of the abundance of the jungle, there are often many new routes created to

the sea. You can also engage in planting activities to help expand the mangrove forest areas in Thailand. Finish off at Station 4: “Forest in the Sea”. With the sunshine and cool breeze, set off on a boat trip to see the fork in the sea, a natural learning center that is the highlight of the Leeled Community as well as one of the most complete ecosystems in Thailand.

Tawarawadee U-Thong Ancient City Community, Suphanburi

Enjoy the history and prosperity of Tawarawadee

Suphan Buri is not just filled with the charms of the Thai countryside. This province near Bangkok also offers historical stories, especially from the Tawarawadee era. Such sights have been transformed into tourist attractions that make the thousand-year-old history documented in textbooks more interesting.



Day 1

Travel to U-Thong District and start getting familiar with the foundation for the history of **Tawarawadee U-Thong Ancient City Community** at the **U-Thong National Museum**, which is distinguished by its artifacts from the excavations of the ancient city of U-Thong. This important city in the Tawarawadee period features stories from more than 3,000 years of prehistoric times. Then proceed to crafting activities with Tawarawadee coin casting in U-Thong, to make a coin that represents the cultural relationship between Thailand and India at **Wichian Foundry**. When you reach the city of U-Thong, pay homage to Luang Phor U-Thong or Phra Phutthapusayakhiri Sri Suvarnabhumi, a buddha statue carved onto a large rock atop Mangon Bin Cliff at the **Large Buddha of Ancient U-Thong**. Take a break for lunch before go-



ing to **Khao Phra Folk Museum**, to learn about the origins of the people in Khao Phra. Then try your hand at making a rattan basket with a local artisan and continue onto **Ban Khok Community** to attend a class on how to make a sweet dessert that helps counter the heat. It's made from **Suphanburi chestnut**, a GI product of the province. Then relax with a foot massage with **Thip Kasorn brand of herbal oil**, a famous OTOP product. In the evening, fill your belly at **Ruen Bu Nga Restaurant**.

Along the watershed forest of the Banthat Mountain Range, Ban Lam Khanun is a small agricultural community that represents the true southern way of life. Today it is preserved through the introduction of new creative developments in tourism that invite travelers to learn more about southern culture. Whether it is Nora or shadow puppets, they can be seen here, as part of the normal way of life at Ban Lam Khanun.



Day 1

Arrive at **Ban Lam Khanun Community** and be welcomed with **Trang roasted pork**, a GI product from Trang that's hot off the grill. Enjoy it with tea served in an aromatic **Theptaro wooden vessel**, a famous OTOP product in the community. Then watch the famous Nora show, a rare cultural performance of the South. You can also choose creative endeavors, turning the shadow puppets into a chic keychain or bag. Next, join

a workshop to make "Kosui", a local dessert and the signature item of Lam Khanun. At lunch, taste delicious southern dishes such as fried fish with turmeric and sataw beans, and Khao Yam made from organic vegetables and the delicious added flavor of golden-black lime, which is

indigenous to Trang. Also, do not miss the local dessert of glutinous rice. In the afternoon, learn about Norabic exercises with real and experienced Nora performers, along with joining a bamboo copter or "luk whiz" workshop, seeing how folk toys are made from local natural materials. In the evening, eat local food and check into a homestay.

Day 2

Wake up early in the peaceful atmosphere of Lam Khanun Community. Get active and go kayaking along the **Phikun River**,



taking in the natural greenery along both sides of the road. Then go to the **agricultural classroom** and learn about crop rotation according to the sufficiency economy principle. Watch beekeeping and honey gathering, and see the birthplace of new species of limes, such as "Sri Thong Dam" or "Khe Khad" limes, that can be eaten whole with the peel. They are sliced and served with a little salt and honey – delicious and refreshing at the same time. Have lunch with the head chef in the community and continue the adventure at **Khao Chang Hai Cave**. Although this cave is not very deep (walk only 500 meters), it contains a complete array of stalagmites and stalactites that



divide the cave into 6 caverns with convenient walkways for novice spelunkers. Then have dinner at **Ruan Sumalee** and check in to the hotel.

Day 3

Visit **Wat Phu Khao Thong**, which is over 1,000 years old and the only place in Thailand to

see a Buddha image reclining in a specific style. Built during the Srivijaya era, the image is more than 8 meters long and over 2 meters wide. Currently, the Fine Arts Department has registered it as a historical site. Before saying goodbye to Trang with a local **frog-headed tuk tuk ride**, wander around Trang, stop to buy Trang roasted pork as a souvenir at **Trang Moo Yang Restaurant**, check-in at the old Trang Clock Tower, etc.

ECO-ADVENTURE TOURISM *Route*

Ban Suan Pa Community, Chiang Rai

Go wild on Chiang Rai's natural adventure route

Ban Suan Pa Community represents a new destination for trekking enthusiasts. Here, there is not only the abundance of natural forests at the foothills but also the story of the Akha ethnic culture which still maintains its traditions alongside new agricultural methods.





Day 1

Chiang Rai is known as a city of art. Many National Artists live and work here, and the first destination when visiting Chiang Rai is definitely **Ban Dam Museum**. The residence and studio of the National Artist Thawan Duchanee, Baan Dum houses a variety of rooms such as a bedroom, an office, and a room with a collection of animal skins and skulls – all of which inspired Thawan's powerful artwork. Next, go eat lunch at **Huan Rom Sri Thong** with a buffet of Chinese desserts in an ancient house

setting. After eating, head up the mountain to continue the adventure at **Doi Tung Tree Top Walk**, an activity that tests your courage. Located at Mae Fah Luang Garden at the Doi Tung Development Project, the walk includes a canopy walkway that's 295 meters long and 30 meters above the ground. See nature up close before changing the setting. Check in among the rice fields at **Ahsa Farmstay** in an old wooden house that has been renovated to be modern but still fits in with the atmosphere of the community. Here, a vegetable

plot and chemical-free fields provide produce that's harvested for cooking.

Day 2

Get ready to go hiking at **Ban Suan Pa Community**, a village at the foot of Doi Tung with a rich forest garden that is a valuable asset. As such, the community has taken advantage of the abundance of the forests and adapted them into a study tour route for local natural flora. Along the way, you will learn about the way of life of the Akha community, such as catching fish in the natural





creek to cook for a simple meal in the forest by the Huai Sai Khao Waterfall. Next, learn about community farming on the hills, where products like cocoa and avocado are prominent. Along the way, take a break with **Doi Chang Coffee**, a GI product of Chiang Rai, where you can boil hot water and prepare drip coffee in the middle of the forest. This experience can be considered to be a day trip full of forest and community lessons at the same time

End your trip at **Flour Flour**, a little bakery shop that focuses on quality, making bread from cultivating natural yeast.

For lunch, savor delicious and fresh seafood at **Bruda Restaurant**, which is situated right in the path of the sea breezes off the gulf in Ban Laem District. For anyone interested in a relaxing massage, it can be had here as well. And for those who want to taste fresh crab

Day 1

Hike through verdant rice fields to the old **Na Phan Sam Community**. Get refreshed with delightful honey lime treats made with Petchaburi lime, a famous GI product. Boasting both sourness and the aroma of citrus rinds, these are a lovely welcome to the community and should not be missed, especially when eaten with **dried, salted limes**. If you prefer sweet goodies, whether Khanom Mo Kaeng, Med Khanoom, Thong Yib, or Thong Yod, their sweetness will temper the sour flavors of the limes. With a full stomach, take an E-Tan truck to **Wat Na Phrom**, where there is an old hall dating back to the Ayutthaya period. Inside, some frescoes are faded, but you can see the beauty of the work by craftsmen in the past. On the way, stop to take photos at the **Thong Urai flower fields**, seasonal blooms that are now a new landmark of community tourism. Take a break for lunch



with local dishes such as Hua Node curry, morning glory curry, and salted fish chili paste flavored with GI product limes. End lunch with sweets and go to a workshop

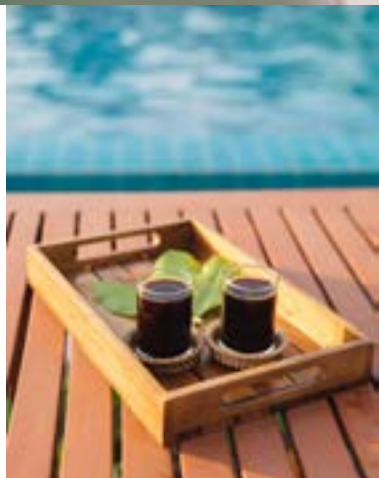




meat from the Gulf of Thailand for dinner, **Krua Rimlay Pu Pen** marks another highlight of the day's program.

Day 3

Local markets often have hidden local delicacies and at **Chao Samran Beach**, there is a morning market with a variety of seafood and local food. Watch a welcome performance by the community youth while enjoying sweet, fragrant pineapple juice and pineapple pie. Then join a workshop on making Khao Tang, the famous rice dish of the community, which is topped with the golden Rayong pineapple; it can be brought back as a special souvenir. Take a break for lunch

with local community dishes, which include a secret recipe of Khao Rang or Rang Krabok. Made from Krabok, it is a must-try local dish. Proceed to the **tri-flavored squid** making workshop using Kopiak brand squid, an OTOP product of the province. Also, don't miss tasting Ban Phe mantis shrimp noodles, before going to experience the way of life of the **Talay Noi Community**, a large vegetable and sprouts growing area. A homestay features the charms of community tourism that will give you a deeper understanding of the local way of life and culture. The same is true when checking in at Baan Na Wa Homestay. It is a community that respects the traditional Tai Yo people's way of life, which is characterized by silk weaving, and thus preserves the old indigo dyeing factory as a center of knowledge that has been passed on to the next generation of Tai Yo descendants.



Day 1

Depart from the airport, and stop for a typical Nakhon Phanom breakfast that combines the diversity of the Mekong lifestyle between Thailand, Laos, and Vietnam into a unique, long-enjoyed local breakfast of wet rice, fried eggs, fried rice, and rice crackers. Then go straight to **Ban Na Wa Community** to pay respect to **Phra That Prasit**. Taste more local food for lunch, which includes the famous pork **Vietnamese Sausage (Moo Yor)**, eaten with the **Nakhon Phanom 1**

variety of lychee, cold cut style. Then continue to the **Ban Tha Ruea Community**, a production center for Northeastern musical instruments, where you can sip on Nakhon Phanom lychee cocktails and watch a performance. The program continues with learning about indigo at Yai Yot Dyeing Factory at Ban Na Wa Community, an old dye facility of Grandma Yot that's been transformed into a chemical-free learning and info dissemination center for indigo, including the way of the Tai Yo tribe and check in **homestay at Yai Yot Dyeing Factory**.

Then travel to **Wat Phra That Phanom**, the center of the faith for locals. Chill by the Mekong River at the chic **8E88eatery cafe** and end the day with a

visit to an **ancient cultural house**. With the heritage of 8 Tai Nakhon tribes and 2 ethnicities, it has become a new landmark in Nakhon Phanom province that offers OTOP products for shopping. Finally, enjoy a delicious dinner along the Mekong River at **Rim Khong restaurant**, which features a menu of Mekong fish dishes as highlights. End the night with the

romance of a sunset cruise on a Mekong River boat.

Day 3

Ao Kram Community, Chumphon

Rest at a homestay, enjoy plenty of seafood, and get ready to learn the ways of the fishermen

Ao Kram is a small fishing community of about 20 houses in Sawi District, Chumphon Province, that welcomes travelers in homestay style. Relax in a wooden house by the sea and learn about the local fishing lifestyle on the Gulf of Thailand. It's akin to being in a seafood market – get on a boat to go shopping every day.

Day 1

Arrive at Chumphon, pay respect to **Krom Luang Chumphon Khet Udomsak Shrine** and stop for lunch at **Pad Thai Tad Ban Mor Taew** to enjoy the famous seafood Pad Thai dish of Sairee Beach that's served on a large tray packed with fresh seafood. Then head to **Ban Koh Tiab Community** that tells the story of the way of life of the local fishing community. The first activity is to release young crabs from the nursery, and then get the lanterns ready for squid fishing. When you arrive at the fishing community, seafood prepared in the bold, flavorful Chumphon style is served for dinner. Tuck into sour soup with squid egg and colocasia stalks, stir fried chive flowers with shrimp, etc. At night, get on a boat to watch the squid netting process, which is a unique local fishery method at **Ban Ao Kram**. And if you're lucky during the



absence of the moon, you might be able to see the rare fluorescent plankton phenomenon. Stay in a homestay where each house has herbal Phukaew products like coconut oil soap, a famous OTOP product from Chumphon, for you to sample.

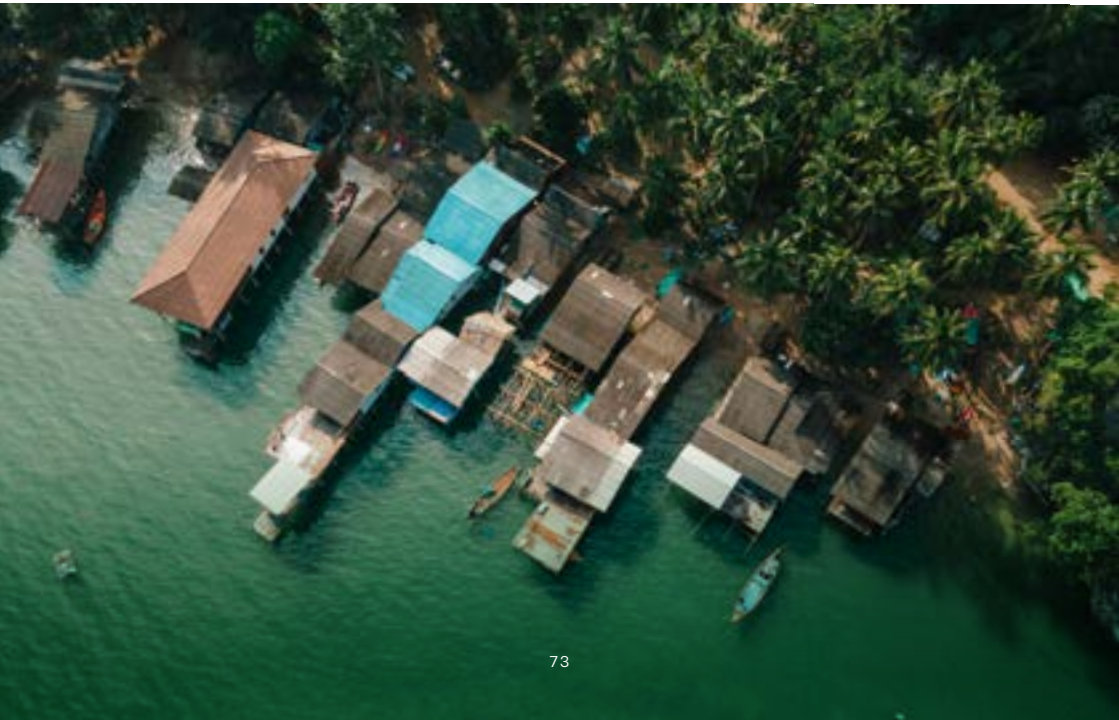

Live a farmer's dream and gain inspiration from an agricultural community that has succeeded in becoming self-reliant at Ban Mae Lan Nuea Community, Phrae Province. A community that brings together knowledge from trial and error in the agricultural endeavors of villagers, it serves as a learning center and famous agricultural tourist attraction of the province.



Day 1

About 45 minutes from Phrae town, **Ban Mae Lan Nuea Community** is full of agricultural learning activities such as cultivating earthworms, growing pak wan pa, and organizing a farm accounting system. In addition to knowledge, visitors gain inspiration and a new perspective of a farmer's career as one that can actually generate income. Once you have your fill of knowledge, fill up on a delicious lunch at **Sunflower Restaurant** with a menu consisting of Khanom



Jeen Nam Yoi, a famous local food of Long District served with the restaurant's signature dried chili paste. After eating, continue on to **Khum Wong Buri**. Not only is the beauty of the Thai-European architecture more than 100 years old, the pink teak house is also like a small museum that tells the complete history of Phrae. Have dinner at **Gingerbread House**; besides coffee, there are also food, drinks, and lovely tie-dyed clothes to buy.

Day 2

Another well-known OTOP and GI product of Phrae is the woven cloth. For those who want to know every step of the production process in depth, they must go to **Mo Hom Pa Ngeem Learning Center**. Take a class to make your own Mo Hom cloth as a souvenir from Phrae. Then have a break at **Baan Kruea Thong**, a hip white cafe that offers homemade cakes, beverages, and Thai fusion foods. Continue learning at **Surasak**



Thong Phrae Community Enterprise, where local liquors are made. Rice is mixed with spices and herbs and distilled into spirits, sato, fruit wines, and special spirits. End the day with dinner at **The Sakthong Cafe'** with a special sato cocktail.



Day 3

It is said that “anyone who comes to Phrae has to buy Mo Hom”, so the next destination is a famous Mo Hom production area called **Baan Thung Hong**, a shopping center for local Mo Hom products and locally dyed fabric in navy blue that represents the uniqueness of the people of Phrae. It is also a local GI product. Then go to fill your tummy at **HOM 2493**, a restaurant in an old house atmosphere that’s located next to the city wall. Here, you will find everything you need for a full meal, including desserts and drinks. The must-try dishes are Ma Kwean fried chicken, Tum Sua, Mee Hom, and sago with

coconut milk. There's no better way to end the trip than with this delicious meal.



It is well known among camping tourists who want to escape the hustle and bustle of the city to rest and listen to the sounds of nature. Sip a warm Robusta coffee and watch the mist and rain drift slowly across the landscape during the end of the rainy season.



Day 1

Travel to **Ban Pa Maak**, a Karen ethnic community along the western Thai border that's located deep in the middle of the forest. The tranquility has become a point of attraction for tourists to pitch tents by the stream. Then get refreshed with **Thap Sakae Coconut Coffee**, a GI product of Prachuap Province, at **Robusta Pa Chang Khao**, the only coffee shop in the village located next to a stream. Enjoy the fragrant aroma of hand-roasted Robusta coffee. Then have lunch by a community chef and enjoy ready-made desserts like **durian cake made from Pala-U durian**, a famous seasonal GI product. You can opt for **desserts made from**

Thap Sakae coconut, also a GI product, as well. Afterwards, explore the community forest path and cool off at a stream in the middle of Pa Mak Village. In the afternoon, relax with a **Ban Ma Rong Herbal Compress Ball**, a famous OTOP product. After having a full dinner, be enchanted by the stargazing activity at the tent site by the stream.

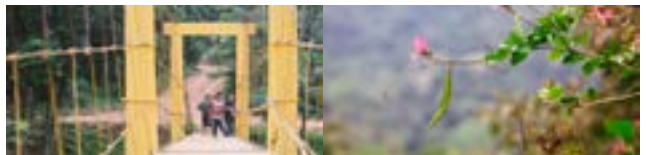

Afterwards, enjoy local flavors such as crab with eggs, clam curry with Cha Plu leaves, mantis shrimp salad with a peanut sauce, and the community’s signature pineapple curry dish. Then enter nature’s classroom, taking a boat along the 4 mangrove forest routes, namely, Jak forest, Chai Lane forest, Kongkang forest, and Lamphun forest. Partake in ecotourism activities like releasing egg-laying crabs back to nature, which helps to increase crab resources in Trat province, followed by a visit to the

“Unseen” sight of Trat Province and Lan Taboon, which boasts different scenes of beauty during high and low tide. You can play a game of bowling with Taboon fruit and admire the scenery on the long bridge. End the day by watching the sunset and sipping a **herbal apple mocktail made with Triphala**, made from Triphala herbal juice, a famous OTOP product of the province. 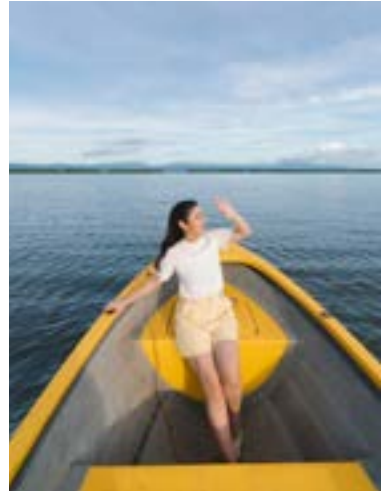

Learn about a model community that lives under the principles of a sufficiency economy, from agricultural tourism. At this destination, learning outside the classroom becomes more fun.



Day 1

Head to the lush Kaeng Krachan District until you reach **Ban Nam Sap Community**, a sufficiency economy model where impoverished conditions have been transformed through sustainable income generation. Upon your arrival, be welcomed with refreshing **palm sugar**, a GI product derived from palmyra trees grown in Phetchaburi. Then start your learning activities at Station 1, which is about the cowboy lifestyle and hippotherapy, and then to Station 2, to learn about the sufficiency farming lifestyle, harvest vegetables, and visit an organic garden. Take a lunch break and enjoy food made by a local chef who uses organic vegetables and processed products famous

in the community as raw materials. Dishes include Pla Som Khua Kling fried rice and black tailed chicken soup. The children's menu includes Kalaa eggs, Chao Samut fried rice, and crisp seafood. Of course, a visit to Phetchaburi would not be complete with **Khanom Mor Gaeng**, a GI product and signature sweets product from the province. In the afternoon,

continue to Station 3, to learn how to make Thong Muan rolls, a wonderful product of Ban Nam Sap. And at Station 4, learn to make a **herbal drink using Phetchaburi limes**. At dinner, go watch the sunset over Kaeng Krachan Dam at **Kaeng Krachan Review**. Then depart Kaeng Krachan to check in and stay at Laem Phak Bia Beach.

Wake up refreshed by the sea and get ready to continue your journey to the estuary for **Brudda Whale** watching from a traditional fishing boat. Day 1

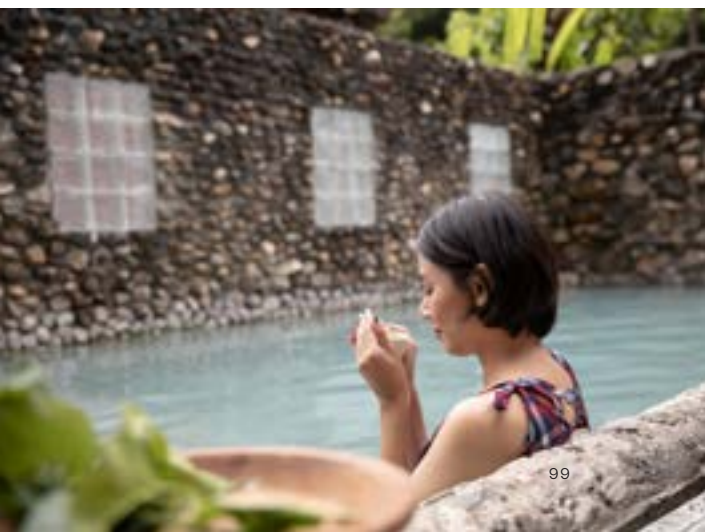

Day 1

From Hat Yai Airport, head to Satun Province, beginning the trip at **Krua Chaisit** restaurant, which serves 100% Halal local food. Then be on your way to **Ban Ton Panan Community**. Be welcomed with **Kopi** and **Fried Champada**, a seasonal GI product grown in Satun that can only be enjoyed from July to September. Proceed to the next station to learn how to prepare coffee in the traditional style, where the community continues to preserve their old methods of pounding coffee. Don't miss out on tasting coffee, based on a secret recipe of Ban Ton Panan Community Enterprise Group. Take a break and recharge with lunch in the community, where villagers cook rice in bamboo stalks according to age-old traditions. After filling your stomach, continue to the

village's Saba courtyard to join a lively Saba competition before changing clothes and relaxing at **Jarood Water Park**, Ban Ton Community's water park that uses water from a natural source, namely, Ton Panan Waterfall. The highlights include the giant slides. After enjoying the day's activities, say goodbye to the community and return to the town of Satun for dinner and to check in to your accommodations.



Day 2

Check out from your accommodations and go unwind and go unwind at **Thung Nui Hot Spring**. This natural, mineral hot spring is suitable for taking a dip to relax the body and mind.
