








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INTRODUCTION

Explore a small community with a scooter. Go to every hidden corner in the market and take memory shots there. Talat Noi is a Chinese community that was extended from the Sampeng community that was a significant commercial zone in the early Rattanakosin Kingdom. The community consists of multicultures from a variety of people and races. It was a crowded place when Ayutthaya was destroyed by the Burmese. The highlight is the street arts, and food like super sticky rice dumpling, café, the old iron-making plant - only one left, ancient car, Paint House, Amazing Thailand Phoenix Wall, Holy Rosary Church, Central Post Office, and more.







Wat Arun Ratchawararam Ratchawaramahawihan

Known as the Temple of Dawn, it is one of the most beautiful temples in Bangkok with its outstanding location beside the Chao Phraya River. A perfect time to visit is early in the morning for the sunrise and late afternoon for the sunset. It was constructed in the Ayutthaya period with the highlights of the main stupa, main hall, and royal sanctuary, where sacred Buddha images are located, including a pair of super giants.

Built in the reign of King Rama I the Great, it is the heart of the Rattanakosin Kingdom with elegance and artistry possessing treasures and culture from the past. It is divided into three main sectors, which are the outside residence, middle residence, and inner residence. The highlight to visit is the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, Phra Maha Montian, Chakri Maha Prasat Throne Hall, Dusit Maha Prasat Throne Hall, and the temple's museum. Moreover, in July 2022, hundreds of ancient human and legendary animal stone-made figures were discovered, which they are believed to have been imported for the temple's decoration over 100 years ago.

WAT PHRA CHETUPHON VIMOLMANGKLARARM RAJWORAMAHAVIHARA (WAT PHO)

Wat Pho is the temple of King Rama I the Great of the Rattanakosin Kingdom, which is one of the significant temples in the capital. The highlight to visit is the massive reclining Buddha image with a length of 46 metres, which is regarded as the third longest reclining Buddha image in the country. Each foot is inlaid with mother of pearl and spiritual carvings related to the Lord Buddha and his teaching. Some believe that it gives good luck for love as well. A massage service is also available in the temple.

King Rama I the Great ordered to construct giants as the temple's guardians, which the giants are smaller in size than the giants from Wat Arun. During his reign, he ordered to build four pairs of giants as the temple door guardians. In the reign of King Rama III, he ordered to replace the damaged giants with Chinese stone dolls and built another eight giants to keep the scripture hall. Later, King Rama IV the Great ordered to renovate the temple and only two pairs of giants were left.

CHAKRABONGSE DINING

One of the best places to see the Chao Phraya River, especially the riverside pavilion where you can see Wat Arun opposite the restaurant. The interior design is mixed Thai-Chinese culture, and the main dish is authentic Thai food from a secret recipe of the Chakrabongse Family. Starting with appetiser, followed by the main dish and dessert to complete luxurious dining.



Recommended menu: Appetiser such as fried banana blossom with red curry paste, minced chicken and sweet corn in a crispy cup, fresh pineapple morsel topped with minced chicken and peanuts, massaman curry with jackfruit, fried river prawns with tamarind sauce, and pomelo salad and fruit.

The Old City Pillar Shrine, which is known by the locals as "Pak Khlong Om the Guardian", is over 400 years old. Originally, it was located at the Mahajestsadabadin Bridge with a replica of an old traditional Thai-styled house and modified when the time changed. It is combined arts between Thai and Chinese culture with an outstanding red and gold colour. The figure of the guardian is made from crafted wood that is rare to find at the present time. Inside the Shrine's hall, there are another five quardians to protect the city's pillar under a belief to protect the city, the people, health, and wealth and investment.

The latest bridge crossing the Chao Phraya River in Nonthaburi harbours a well-known activity of street arts, which is very close to Chaloem Kanchanaphisek Park and the Old City Pillar Shrine, or Bang Sri Mueang side. The art tells a story of the top products in the province like durian, a home of crocodiles in the past, Old City Hall, pottery, and traditional festivals. Enjoying a relaxing moment with a view of the river at the bridge is recommended.

OLD NONTHABURI CITY HALL / NONTHABURI MUSEUM

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Being built in the year 1910, the City Hall had an original Western design with whole teak wood encountering the Chao Phraya River. The design was adapted to make it in line with the local climate. The main compound was surrounded by seven two-storey buildings. Originally, it was planned to be a law school, but later it become a college inspired by King's College in the UK. It is a nice place for shooting photos, especially the crafted wooden corridor on the second floor. The Museum is nearby and is divided into eight rooms; each tells a different story of Nonthaburi from the past to the present.

WAT CHALOEM PHRA KIAT WORAWIHAN

It is a perfect place to see flocks of birds in the city, such as peacock, spotted owlet and endangerd Alexandrine parakeet amidst a green landscape along the river. Being built from a fortress, the temple was built by King Rama III who wanted to honour his grandparents. The design is perfect with well-blended Thai and Chinese culture. The major Buddha image is related to Wat Ratchanatdaram in Bangkok.

BUDDHIST SITE OF CHUENG THA-NA BOT

It is an ancient temple built in the mid-Ayutthaya period. However, in 1963, the Department of Royal Irrigation made land expropriation from the two temples and the nearby communities. So, there is only the Buddha image left in the temples with no monks. A famous figure is "Luangpho Suea Dam" or black tiger venerable monk, which is well-known for bringing good fortune to those who pay homage.

KO KRET

Being an islet in the middle of the Chao Phraya River, it is a very tranquil local community. Hence, to make it more colourful, travel with a scooter is one interesting option, as it is a vehicle to make you move faster and closer to the place. The highlight is the tilted pagoda at Wat Poramaiyikawas Worawihan, which is also the province's symbol. Coffee making is very unique at "Kuaw Mur", which the clients must roast the coffee by themselves. Finish the trip at "Rongsi Studio", which is an old mill and modified into a restaurant with an outdoor and indoor zone. The menu also has a variety, such as deep-fried fish with fresh herbs and tamarind sauce, grilled river prawns, roasted chicken in a jar, butterfly pea in coconut water, and strawberry yoghurt.

WAT BANG RAHONG

Located at Khlong Om Non, which is full of many sightseeing places, the temple was constructed by a Mon person named Mr Hong who had escaped the war in Burma (present-day Myanmar) and relocated to this place. He later developed his own fortune and decided to build a temple. Its outstanding point is the over 200-year-old chapel to enshrine "Luangpho Rian", which the people pay respect for receiving a wish for prosperity and health.

WAT KU (WAT PHRANANG RUEA LOM)

It is believed that Phraya Cheng, who was a Mon, ordered to construct the temple while moving to stay at Nonthaburi's Ko Kret. As such, the art decoration is a taste from the Mon culture, such as wall murals in the chapel depicting about its history, Buddha images, and the chedi. The Chao Phraya River is behind the temple. Moreover, the temple was involved in the tragic death of the Queen of King Rama V the Great and their daughter whose life was loss when their boat capsized near the temple. Another name of the temple is Wat Phranang Ruea Lom, which means the temple of a lady whose boat capsized.

Aged over 300 years, the temple, with the former name of "Bung Luang", which means hidden from the state, is outstanding with ancient Thai and Mon-style architecture, such as two Mon-style chedis, wall murals with the story of Lord Buddha, and the main hall with the grand Buddha image in the posture of subduing Mara.

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Constructed by the Mon people, the main hall has no pillars, which is different from the ordinary style. The grand Buddha image is named "Luangpho Yai", which is the oldest image in the province. Moreover, it has "Luangpho Phet", which is a Buddha image in the posture of subduing Mara crossed with the diamond meditation. His left hand is adjustable that is done by ancient wisdom. 
WAT CHIN WARARAM WORAWIHAN

Located on the bank of the Chao Phraya River and the Nonthaburi-Bang Bua Thong Bridge, it has a terrace to see the river view all day. The old temple was constructed in 1815 in the Rattanakosin era with two temples nearby. They were later restored in the reign of King Rama VII. Inside the main hall, there is an ancient Buddha sculpture named Phra Phuttha Chinnavon (Luangpho Thongkam) that was originally from Ayutthaya province. It was created under the influence of the art of the Sukhothai period. Simultaneously, the wall murals are about the Lord Buddha's reincarnations. The highlight is a new square structure with four arches and a pyramidal roof based on the original style. It is a nice place to see the beauty of the Chao Phraya River.










However, there was some conflict with the local people, so the abbot made a wish by saying that "If a knife could be floated, I could stay here. If not, I would go." The locals at last witnessed the knife floating and allowed them to stay.



The highlight is the main hall, which is the original building, but some parts were elevated due to major flooding in 2011. There are four grand Buddha images, which their face is turned into different directions with the belief to protect each direction from evil. The temple was also found to be a historical site due to the discovery of pottery - great evidence to confirm an ancient Mon community. The unearthed items are kept in the temple's museum.




Wat Phutthaisawan




