The 350 berths complement luxury waterfront condos and villas. The berths range from 10-35 metres and are fully equipped with electricity, water, high-speed wireless broadband, TV, and telephones. The 60 tonne travel-lift with lifting bay is 16 metres deep and 5.8 metres wide. A unique concierge marina service takes care of residents and visiting yachts.




PHUKET BOAT LAGOON



LUXURY MOTOR YACHT MIA KAI





Meanby Tourist Attractions

Phuket is among the world's finest beach destinations, with palm-fringed fine white sand, glittering seas and lively towns. The island caters for a array of tastes and budgets, with hundreds of hotels to choose from, an eclectic choice of dining and plenty of partying options. Aside from visiting the fantastic attractions of Thailand's biggest island, you can take a trip to the many nearby tropical islands.





Koh Phi Phi

The Phi Phi Islands are a small group of islands generally referred to as one: Koh Phi Phi, not far from Phuket. Famous for white sandy beaches and fringing coral reef, the main island of Phi Phi Don has several resorts, while the smaller Phi Phi Lai is a popular day trip destination from both Phi Phi Don and Phuket itself.





Railay and Phra Mang Beach

Phra Nang Beach is the southern strip of sand in Railay Bay in Krabi Province, a 20-minute long-tail boat trip from Ao Nang, or 10 minutes by foot from Railay East. The beach features soft white sand, clear shallow water for safe swimming, pretty fringing reef, with two small islands nearby (Koh Rang Nok and Nai), and caves to explore. All this set against a backdrop of picturesque limestone cliffs very popular for rock climbing.






Similar Islands

The Similan Islands National Park is an archipelago in the southern Andaman Sea, very popular for snorkelling and scuba diving. Open to public between October to May, the islands can be reached by day trip from Phuket the islands are a popular destination for yacht charters.





Racha Islands

These two islands Racha Yai Island and Racha Noi are located around 12km south of Phuket, popular for day trips, with picturesque white sandy beaches and great snorkelling and scuba diving on the fringing reefs.





Krabi

Krabi is around 2.5 hours drive from Phuket airport, a province characterized by craggy, sheer limestone cliffs, dense mangrove forests, and more than a hundred offshore islands.





Koh Rok

Famous for snorkelling, scuba diving as well as camping, Koh Rok is part of Mu Koh Lanta Marine National Park.
The name applies to the twin islands of Koh Rok Nai and Koh Rok Nok which are about 200m apart, surrounded by beautiful fringing coral.





Mai Khao Beach

Mai Khao Beach is the longest beach on Phuket. Mai Khao Beach is on the northwest coast of Phuket. This 11-km-long straight beach is still relatively undeveloped as it's part of the Sirinat National Park.





Naiyang Beach

Not far from Mai Khao Beach, Naiyang beach is famous mainly because it is under the approach path for Phuket Airport, so the subject of many selfies with low-flying planes.





Surin Beach

Surin Beach is one of Phuket most beautiful bays, with a white sandy beach, clear water and several small Thai style restaurants.






Blue Tree Phuket






Karon View Point

Pronthep Cape

Promthep Cape is the southern-most point of Phuket. Due to its location and southern facing views, it offers a picturesque view of the Andaman Sea.





Phuket Old Town

Lively Phuket Old Town is known for brightly painted, century-old Sino-Portuguese townhouses, with a wellpreserved row along Soi Rommanee.





Chalong Temple

Wat Chalong, the largest, most revered and most visited Buddhist temple in Phuket was built at the beginning of the 19th century and is one of the must-see places in Phuket.
