












technology to help detect the number of people in a certain area to reduce the power used for air conditioners to control the temperature, plus it saves energy as well.






Interestingly, this hotel was originally conceptualised as an eco-friendly hotel from the start.





If you fall in love with Nimman, Christophe Gestin, General Manager, would like to introduce you to 'Akyra Manor Chiang Mai,' a compact luxury hotel, which is the first hotel in Nimman Hemin. It has been opened for 7 years as an accommodation under the Akaryn Hotel Group, joining hands with the Manor Group, in the name Akyra Manor Chiang Mai.

The Akaryn Hotel Group has a policy to refrain from using single-use plastics. The policy includes switching from plastic straws to plant-made ones, and changing bathroom packaging from plastic to ceramic refillable bottles. Furthermore, the waste is sorted and managed properly, even the garbage bags in the rooms have been switched to linen bags. Moreover, the hotel kitchen prefers cooking ingredients and material produced in Chiang Mai to imported from abroad. This is to support local shops and small businesses.







When you come to relax here, you must not miss the charm of the Nimman area, which is full of variety, including cafés, international restaurants, bookstores, and small galleries filled with creative people. Whether by walking or cycling around the area, you can explore and get to know the district equally enjoyable.


"We want everyone to know and remember U Chiang Mai as the first U hotel in Chiang Mai in the heart of Wiang district, close to Wat Chedi Luang and, also, as a hotel that has a full 'U' service culture."

Hotel Manager, tells us with a smile, whole-heartly determined for people to truly get to know U Chiang Mai Hotel. "U Chiang Mai is now the first hotel in the chain to use glass bottles instead of plastic ones. Gradually, the light bulbs are being replaced








with LEDs. We also switch to paper straws, and plant a small vegetable garden to be served in our dining room."

In the future, hospitality executives and investors will turn to new technologies, which save or reduce the use of energy. It is imperative that sustainability is achieved in the hospitality business."

Of course, the consumer trend has come. We, therefore, want to be a green hotel that responds to and supports customers in this matter." Boonchuay Kiatbhatkul, Head of the Engineering Department, tells us about the good outcome that will happen if the adaption and revolution to the concept of sustainability starts.

A European-style luxury hotel that is reaching its 14th year has begun taking part in saving the world. They started with turning plastic water bottles into glass ones, changing soap and shampoo bottles to portable size which are refillable at any time, and replacing fluorescent bulbs with energy-saving LED lights. Moreover, vegetable








gardens are planted in various areas of the hotel, and food waste is controlled and handled from the beginning.

This project includes collaboration with the local community to develop and clean public places; such as, temples, communities, and roads. Le Méridien Chiang Mai cooperates with the local municipality to make Khlong Mae Kha clean by making sure that wastewater is handled properly and releasing only good quality clear water into the canal. The hotel also supports the locals and handicrafts with the Bo Sang Umbrella Group, San Kamphaeng district in promoting travel programmes.










definitely beneficial not only for the hotel in terms of cost savings and energy saving, but also for the world.



She started with the most essential part, which was to make the executives truly understand sustainability. Then she formulated policies and work plans and, finally, real practice.

Duangtawan Hotel has been doing for 10 years is to reduce carbon emissions by turning to LED lights, using recyclable items; such as, using both sides of paper then make it into a paper bag with some portion donated to schools for the blind. They can reduce the use of foam and plastic by 100 percent. The wastewater is recycled into the hotel and used once more before being released. This project includes separating waste mindfully from the source. In terms of food waste management, they try to minimise the amount of waste as much as possible. They also support local businesses in Chiang Mai.







"We want to see tourists become more environmentally aware and to see that hotels in Chiang Mai are a green hotel. We want our home environment to return to how it was in the past. We want everyone to understand their role that is to preserve and live with the environment. We really want to see sustainability which everyone realises, recognises, and actually works together towards it."
