Gazing serenely over the mountain valley and scenic rice paddies, "Phra Chao Ton Luang" is the only great Buddha sculpture in Thailand holding the fruit "Samor" (chebulic myrobalan) in his hand. Samor is a medicinal fruit used in Ayurveda, so many people believe that Phra Chao Ton Luang has the power to heal the body and soul. Visitors and worshipers always offer Samor fruit to the Great Buddha and wish for a healthy life. Set in the tranquil landscape, "Na Khu Ha Village" is the ideal place to soak up the serenity of this lush paradise and breathe in the ultra-pure air.






The Pride of Lanna Wat Phra That Suthon Mongkhon Khiri

Unveiling the Majestic Pang Maravihaya Buddha Image - A Stately Marvel of 568 Years, Enshrined at Wat Phong Sunan for its auspicious name, 'Phra Chao Saen Suk'. (The word 'Saen Suk' means 'full of happiness' in the Thai language)As the tale tells, the people of Phrae and neighboring provinces believe that those who pay reverence to Phra Chao Saen Suk will live happily ever after. The exciting sights at Wat Phong Sunan are a distinctive white vihara topped with small gold-tipped spires and a sculpture of Phra Chao Thanchai.

Wat Phrathat Pu Chae is a modest but graceful temple nestled amid the mountain landscape and lush forest. Its gleaming golden pagoda, set against the white-washed building and an azure sky is an awesome sight. The ancient pagoda is one of Phrae Buddhism's holiest sites, as it contains the relics of the right ankle of Buddha. Besides being a significant spiritual site, the temple is in the heart of a scenic valley, where visitors may see the holy pagoda standing in the mist.

Unlocking the Secrets to Evade Misfortune and Peril Wat Chom Khiri Chai (Huay Kud)

Built on a hilltop in Denchai District, the temple of Wat Chom Khiri Chai is home to the "Luang Pho Leklai" Buddha sculpture. Those with a superstitious point of view, believe that if you walk under the base of the Buddha image you will be protected from danger. Outside the vihara is "Chao Mae Ta Kianthong" (possessed ironwood) – where visitors can pray for a "correct" lottery number.

It is also the location of the replica of "Kyaiktiyo Pagoda" suspended relic pagoda.





Baby Be Blessed Wat Si Khom Kham


Built around the 15th century, Wat Si Khom Kham, or Wat Phra Chao Ton Luang, is the most important temple of Phayao. It houses "Phra Chao Ton Luang", the largest and oldest Chiang Saen-style Buddha image in the Lanna Kingdom. The bronze Buddha image in the subduing Mara posture is revered by the people of Phayao. Couples desiring a child pray to Phra Chao Ton Luang for a successful pregnancy. Another must-see attraction is Wat Si Khom Kham's overwater Ubosot, (Ordination Hall). The exquisite mural painting by Angkarn Kalayaanapong, a National Artist of Thailand, will mesmerize you as you pass through the Ubosot.

Where Hope Meets Reality Wat Si Chum

"Phra Chao Thanjai," which is considered to be around 800 years old, was built with a profound faith in Buddhism. During World War II, the exquisite bronze Buddha statue vanished from the temple. Seven decades passed before this revered Buddha image was returned to the Phayao people. Phra Chao Thanjai is well-known for fulfilling the wishes of devotees, therefore many people throng to the temple with high hopes in the power of the sacred Buddha statue.

A Fortress of Faith Wat Analyo Thipphayaram

Wat Analyo is located on the foothills of Doi Bussarakham and is surrounded by lush tropical gardens with a true jungle feel. The temple features beautiful Lanna-style art and architecture and a Bodhgaya replica. It's believed to be a special sanctuary for persons born in the year of the snake. People pray to Ong Pu Dum, the oldest Thao Wessuwan (giant king) in Phayao, for wealth, pregnancy, and good fortune.

The Hidden Cupid Wat Nantaram

Wat Nantaram, with its delicate Thai Yai woodcarving is a unique wonder. The Vihara was built with teakwood and decorated with exquisitely carved wood gables and window panels. The Vihara houses "Pra Putta Metta", a Thai, Yai-style, carved-lacquered and gilded golden teakwood Buddha figure in the subduing Mara pose. If you look carefully at the back of the Buddha statue, you will notice a carving that resembles Cupid, the Greek deity of love. Therefore, couples and singletons pray to Pra Putta Metta for a happy love life.

Secrets of Success Wat Chedi Luang Varavihara

Located in the center of Chiang Mai, this 600-year-old temple was named after the city's largest Buddhist chedi, Chedi Luang. The original chedi was finished in 1481 during King Mengrai's reign. The current Chedi Luang is a reconstruction of this original structure, which was demolished in 1545 due to an earthquake. The temple holds several sacred treasures, including the enormous reclining Buddha "Pra Chao Som Pradthana" and a revered standing Buddha statue, Phra Chao Attarot. The biggest attraction for businesses and celebrities is "San Thao Kumpan (Kumbhanda Shrine)," which houses two Kumbhandas thought to bestow success in business and endow blissful love.

Wat Chiang Man, Chiang Mai's oldest temple, was established in 1296 by King Mengrai of the Lanna kingdom. The temple is well-known for its Lanna-style chedi supported by rows of elephant-shaped buttresses and the famed mural depicting the inauguration of Wat Chiang Man. The exquisite Lanna-style ordination hall has an ancient Buddha image known as Phra Kaew Khao, which is highly respected by Chiang Mai residents. Most people go to the temple to pray for health and longevity, just like the temple which has stood the test of time. History buffs will appreciate Wat Chiang Man's stone tablets, which narrate stories of the past.

The ancient temple Wat Lok Moli houses one of the most impressive chedis in Chiang Mai. The massive chedi contains the ashes of many kings of the Mengrai dynasty that governed the Lanna Kingdom from the late 13th century until 1558. The temple became well-known among the younger generation as a mystical location to pray for true love. They gather around the Pra Nang Chiraprapha Maha Thevi (Queen Chiraprapha) statue, who was also known as the Goddess of Love by young believers and pray for true love. But your desire must be heartfelt as it's believed that only requests from those who genuinely want to discover their true love will be granted.

Embrace the Divine Vibes Wat Pa Dad

Wat Pa Dad is often crowded with visitors who come to worship the elephant-headed Hindu god Ganesha, the god of success. Uttara Sri Ganapati is the name given to this statue, which means Ganesha, "who bestows success in the North". The blackened bronze Ganesha statue has four arms holding a Vajra, a noose, a broken tusk, and a bowl of his favorite dessert. A Brahmin would perform Arti, a Hindu ritual in which light, (typically from a flame), is waved in the air for the respect of deities.

At the Speed of Light Wat Jed Yot, Phra Aram Luang

Wat Jed Yot is a pilgrimage site for persons born in the year of the Snake. It is one of the oldest Buddhist temples in Chiang Mai. The temple is primarily renowned for a cluster of seven stupas that crown the flat roof of the rectangular windowless building, giving it the name Wat Jed Yot (Seven Spires Temple). The main stupa, encircled by six smaller stupas, was inspired by Buddha Gaya Stupa in India. Worshipers particularly revere the 800-year-old "Pra Chao Than Jai" Buddha image because it's believed the kind deity quickly grants their wishes.

But you only get ONE wish! To send your "Direct Message (DM)" to the deity, carefully roll two banknotes together before placing them in the deity's hand, make your wish and then touch your forehead gently to Thep Thanjai's pointing finger. When that's done, place one of the two banknotes in the donation box. Imprint the Devaraj Neramit talisman stamp on the remaining banknote and keep it with you for good luck.

Wat Suthatthepwararam, also known as Wat Suthat, is a refuge for those who believe they are trapped by past sins or the sin of breaking a vow. As an apology for past wrongdoings, they pray and chant the Suntreewanee incantation to Luang Po Glak Fin (Opium Canister Buddha). Made from confiscated opium boxes, Luang Po Glak Fin or Phra Buddha Sethamuni, symbolizes someone who turns over a new leaf. The worshipers will sincerely apologize to their Chao Kam Nai Wen, (karma) ghosts who hold grudges against them from their previous lives, so they can break free of each other. This temple is an excellent spot to go if you're feeling unlucky and want to be blessed with new vitality.







Pray to Si Prachan's Buddha for Protection and Good Fortune Wat Pang Muang


The historic temple of Wat Pang Muang is one of the spiritual landmarks with mystical stories. The temple houses, the 700-year-old Phra Phuttasophit Buddha, which was relocated from Bangkok during World War II. Wat Liab, the previous temple where the Buddha was enshrined and destroyed during the war. However, legend has it - the Buddha sculpture was left without a scratch before being relocated to Wat Pang Muang. This led to the start of the belief among many people that the Buddha has the power to ward off dangers and also bring a worshiper good luck. Aside from the protection Buddha, Wat Pang Muang is well-known for the sculpture of Thao Wessuwan (the Giant King). Believers pray to the Lord of Ghosts to transform their unfavorable year (gae chong) into one filled with good fortune.



A Good Deed Is the Best Prayer Pu U Lue Shrine



The Legend Lives On Wat Huay Hin Haep, Bueng Khong Long District



The sun-cracked stone and bumps resemble the head of a huge serpent, similar to the one in the Naga Cave. The legend of Wat Huay Hin Haep's Bathing Naga became viral, bringing Naga devotees to the temple. According to local legend, the temple also holds a statue of "Praya Sri Suddho Naga," the Naga King who built the Mekong River to settle an argument with his friend Praya Sri Satta Naga. Naga devotees pray to the Naga King for a quick granting of their wishes.








Sanctuary in the Mist Wat Chetiya Khiri Wihan (Wat Phu Thok), Na Saeng Sub-District

Mesmerizing Overwater Glass Ordination Hall Wat Weerachot Thammaram

A stunning feature of Wat Weerachot Thammaram is the glass chapel, (Ubosot) on water. 

4. Tharue City Pillar Shrine (Chao Mae Yai Duang)



A Gift From Heaven Pud Jor Shrine





The Soul of Nora, the Soul of Southern Thailand. Wat Phu Khaothong










Staring Contest Game with a Goddess Keng Chio Hoi Kuan Shrine (Chao Mae Tuptim Shrine)
