HANUMAN WORLD, PHUKET



- 3. Dinosaur Hunter Training School: Providing a play-and-learn experience for young explorers, including dinosaur excavation activities and more.

KHON KAEN ZOO, KHON KAEN

Khon Kaen Zoo: The Good Adventure Park & Camping is a captivating destination nestled in the Thung San Kwang Highlands of the Khao Suan Kwang district in Khon Kaen province. Featuring natural rock formations dating back to the Cretaceous period, approximately 140 million years ago, the zoo is dedicated to wildlife conservation, research, and breeding. Open daily, it serves as both a natural learning hub and a serene retreat. The zoo offers educational programs, captivating shows featuring seals, a capybara parade, and feeding sessions with various animals, including deer, giraffes, elephants, sun conures, and penguins. Notable attractions include the Stone Garden Tour, the country's longest skywalk (the giraffe-patterned Skywalk), and the Glass Bridge, providing panoramic views of African wildlife.

ROI ET TOWER, ROI ET

Roi Et Tower, standing at 101 meters in the heart of Roi Et, is an iconic structure offering panoramic views of the city. With 35 floors, it hosts an exhibition featuring the traditional Thai musical instrument 'Wot,' which is an Isan circular panpipe. The tower also provides various facilities for relaxation, including coffee shops and souvenir stores. On the 31st and 34th floors, visitors can enjoy a 360-degree view of the city. For the adventurous, the tower offers a Sky Walk and a Zipline. The zipline, spanning 350 meters from the 34th floor to an island in Phlan Chai lake, provides an exhilarating experience. The 35th floor houses Buddha's relics and Roi Et's sacred Buddha image, Phra Phuttha Ming Mueang Mongkol. Additionally, the 33rd floor serves as a space for rotating exhibitions about Lifelong Learning.

DHANABADEE CERAMIC MUSEUM, LAMPANG

The Dhanabadee Ceramic Museum is a historical destination that traces the origin of the famous 'Cham Gai' or rooster-pattern bowls of Lampang. Within its premises, the museum narrates the journey of the pioneer who discovered Kaolin (white clay), the main raw material for producing ceramics. This pioneer established the first ceramic factory, producing the renowned 'Cham Gai' of Lampang. The legacy is carried on by the present-day second-generation heir. Ultimately, 'Cham Gai' of Lampang was registered as a Geographical Indication Product. The factory, with the authentic atmosphere of an original facility that is nearly 60 years old, continues to produce hand-painted 'Cham Gai.' The museum takes pride in preserving the oldest traditional dragon kiln, registered as a national heritage site. Visitors can engage in various ceramic painting activities and purchase quality ceramics and home décor items as souvenirs.

On December 26, 2016, it was officially declared as Namtok Chet Sao Noi National Park, making it the first national park in the reign of King Rama X of Thailand. The park features seven-tiered waterfalls and offers various natural tourism activities. It is accessible to people of all ages, providing year-round opportunities for water recreation.

THE COIN MUSEUM, BANGKOK

The Coin Museum, under the Treasury Department of the Ministry of Finance, is Thailand's largest numismatic museum. It houses an extensive collection of over 4,000 items, featuring both Thai and foreign coins. Notable exhibits include the first Thai flat round coin, the largest Pod Duang (an ancient Thai round coin shaped like a grub), and a foreign coin with the embedded DNA of a living being. By utilizing various technologies, the museum provides an interactive and creative learning experience. With Universal Design in mind, the museum boasts a comfortable learning space and inclusive facilities.

HELLFIRE PASS INTERPRETIVE CENTRE, KANCHANABURI

Hellfire Pass Interpretive Centre is a significant memorial site, commemorating the events surrounding the construction of the Thai-Burma Railway during World War II. Positioned approximately at kilometer 150, it signifies the location of the Konyu Cutting, the largest and deepest cutting on the 415-kilometer railway. The pass earned its name 'Hellfire Pass' due to the harsh conditions and urgency during construction, resulting in substantial human losses. Today, the center serves as a poignant reminder of the sacrifices made and is managed by the Australian government. It has evolved into a crucial and educational destination, highlighting the historical significance of the area.

PHETCHABUN INTRACHAI ARCHAEOLOGY HALL, PHETCHABUN

The Phetchabun Intrachai Archaeology Hall was originally built in 1962 as Phetchabun City Hall. When a new City Hall was constructed in 2007, the Municipal Office initiated the renovation of the old building to establish a museum showcasing the history, archaeology, culture, traditions, and lifestyles of the people of Phetchabun using modern mixed media. 
