Beliefs and methods of worship:

It is believed that if you come to pay respects and make a wish to Phra That Doi Suthep, you will only have success, your wishes will be fulfilled, and you will be free from all your obstacles. To worship the relics, you should prepare rice crackers, flowers, incense sticks, and candles. Walk around the right side of the temple for three times while paying respects to the relics and making a prayer for what you desire to be fulfilled. Make sure you pay homage to all the four directions of the relics, which provide different benefits. These include:

North: Wish for wisdom like the full moon.

East: Wish to go to Heaven.

West: Facing west is the highest reverence and worship towards the sacred relic.

South: Wish to become a monk and be ordained in Buddhism.

Don't forget to stop by and pay respects to the monument of Kruba Srivichai, a Lanna saint who is enshrined at the foot of Doi Suthep for good fortune as well.





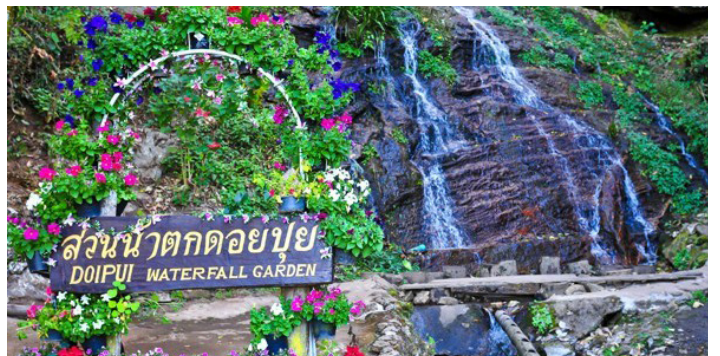
Before going back, stop and take a stroll at...

Hmong Doi Pui Village

Following the trail of fresh ingredients, be sure to visit the strawberry terrace plantation, which are planted in cascades along the mountainside. The atmosphere is beautiful, mixed with mist and cool weather throughout the year. As a result, the strawberries here are large, bright red, and sweet in flavor. They also grow cape gooseberries, arabica coffee, and a flower garden, following in the footsteps of His Majesty King Rama IX in the form of the Sufficiency Agriculture method. The quality ingredients are delivered directly to “Royal Project Kitchen”, which is located in the area of Royal Park Ratchaphruek (the area next to the road), about 300 meters before reaching the entrance to Wat Phra That Doi Kham. Every menu item in the restaurant uses fresh ingredients, obtained from the products of the Royal Project and Thai mountain people that have received support from the Highland Research and Development Institute. The restaurant has a nice garden with an area to sip coffee and eat food. You can sit on the “Hmong Swing” and admire the grapevines that are producing fruit to be used in the Royal Project Kitchen.

Let's go up the mountain and follow the trail of good ingredients in Chiang Mai by continuing on to...

Angkhang Royal Agricultural Station

This was the first royal project of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej, King Rama IX, to promote agricultural careers for farmers instead of them growing opium under His Majesty's concept of “help them help themselves”. The opium farms were changed to winter agricultural plots. Various winter fruits are grown, including peaches, plums, persimmons, pears, kiwifruit, raspberries, blueberries, and strawberries. There are 80 royal varieties, grown in the terrace plantation, which is looked after by Thai mountain villagers. It also includes a greenhouse that collects winter vegetables for tourists to visit and admire the cabbages, melons, eggplants, carrots, and beans. Another place is the “Tea Plantation 2000”, a terraced tea plantation running along the mountainside with cool weather. In the winter, there will be fog floating everywhere, suitable for enjoying the view in the morning or in the evening every day. Just hearing this makes us want to travel. A trip up north during the winter is a must!!!!

Royal Agricultural Station Inthanon

Another research station of the Royal Project Foundation that was created to promote the careers of farming families in this area to grow quality organic vegetables and Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) vegetables. It later developed into another important tourist attraction in Chiang Mai. With good weather, both winter crops and fruits are able to grow for us to eat throughout the year. These include cabbage, red cherry tomatoes, Royal Project tomatoes, green bell peppers, zucchinis, green beans, celery, chayote leaves, fennel, Japanese scallions, pak choy, baby pak choy, baby carrots, bok choy, Chinese kale, green oak leaf, portobello mushroom, and champignon mushrooms. It's hard to believe that so many species come from here!!! There are also fruits such as peaches, persimmons, kiwis, plums, avocados, mangoes, strawberries, cape gooseberries, mulberries, passion fruit, figs, guavas, and grapes. They are all delivered fresh to our hands for you to enjoy.

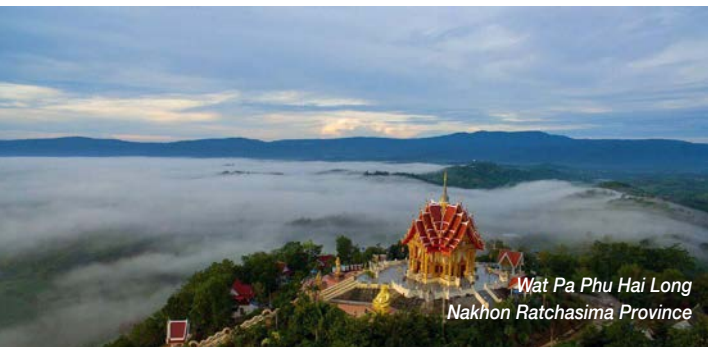

When talking about fun and friendliness, this is it... “Having fun in Isaan”

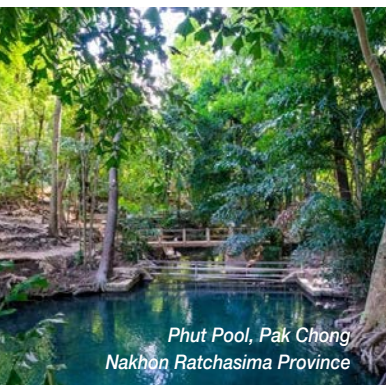

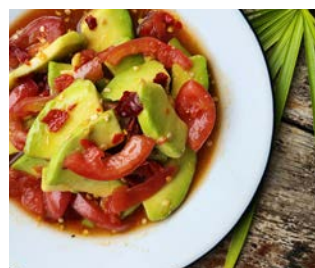

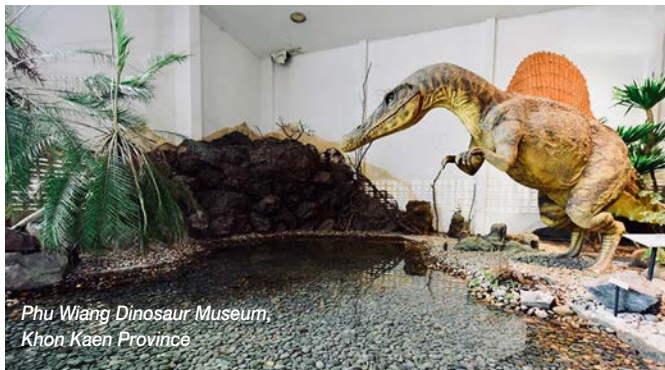
Explore the ancient world at...

The first Thai dinosaur fossil was found in Phu Wiang District in Khon Kaen Province, making it an important tourist destination. It is one of the places in Khon Kaen that is suitable for tourists of all genders and ages. It is enjoyable, exciting, and educating all at the same time. From then on, visit the Thung Setthi Temple, another beautiful temple recommended to visit in Khon Kaen. There is a combination of three-world chedis, namely the Chedi Chula Mani located on the second heaven of Buddhist Cosmology, Naga Chedi (underworld), and Maha Rattana Chedi Si Trai Lakkathat (human world). It is believed that this point is the area that connects the three worlds: heaven, humans, and the underground city.

Cutting through the city... Get ready to learn and try to make natural cotton in your own style. Start from spinning the cotton fluff into cotton yarn. You then dye it with natural dyes from local plants, before bringing it to be woven and processed through the guidance of the elders who started the wisdom of Farm to Fabric together at Folkcharm. Feast on rice wrapped in banana leaves and local food from organic ingredients. It is made by the elders that will allow you to experience nature, rehabilitate your body and mind, ready to change perspectives and new ideas to adjust your current life to connect with nature. Local philosophers, community leaders in the natural agriculture sector, and the Khun Khun Loei Community Enterprise Group gather here to teach and exchange how to live together with nature on the Phu Luang mountain range and the impact of sustainable development on the ecosystem. You can learn from Mae Ros and the female heroes of Ban Na Nong Bong that use weaving as a tool to fight power and preserve community forests. You can study fashion business concepts for society and work collaboratively with the community. You will understand the connection between producing clothes that supports a slow lifestyle, giving importance to the quality of workmanship and time according to the unique style of each elder in the community. They value fair trade, providing value through setting prices that are fully agreed upon with the community. A price that is transparent and fair that was fused and became "Folkcharm", a source for clothes, jewelry, bags, and souvenirs from the wisdom that have been passed on from generation to generation.

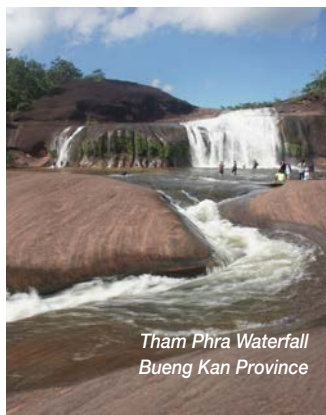
See nature and experience the charm of the Mekong River at...

The first picture when talking about Bueng Kan Province, we often think of beautiful nature such as the Hin Sam Wan, which is considered an extraordinary beauty of nature. It looks like a family of whales that has a father whale, mother whale, and baby whales. Another place that shouldn't be missed is Tham Phra Waterfall located within the Phu Wua Forest Animal Conservation Area. It is a waterfall from a large rock cliff, flowing down onto an open rocky area approximately 100 meters wide. It becomes a swimming area similar to a large water park, which has large body of water that is very clear and beautiful. You can end the trip with... Naka Cave, the faith of the Naka City, because the story and strength of faith has been with Thai people for a long time. People often come to pay homage and pray for good fortune here. Inside the cave on the walls are appearances of what resembles the scales of the Naka that is curled up. The Naka's head and scales can be seen on the large brown rocks. This spot is a popular place for tourists to come and worship. They ask for luck, fortune, and auspiciousness for their lives. According to ancient beliefs, this place was once the homes of the Nakas who lived together with humans to protect them from danger. It is considered to be another unseen spot that you must travel to experience for yourself at least once in your life.

The origin of the charm of woven fabrics in the Mekong River...

Besides the beautiful nature, Bueng Kan Province is also famous for its woven fabrics, one of which is weaving Pha Khao Ma (loincloth) with natural dyes soaked in mud from the Mekong River. The Baan Sa Ngo community weaves local cotton fabric through the wisdom of the elders in the village. The new generation use plants that can be found in the local area like the green areca nut, the skin of wild apple trees, and the bark of the Ratchaphruek tree to dye the fabric. They soak the fabric in mud from the Mekong River to make the fabric softer and the color more durable. There are more than 12 unique Pha Khao Ma patterns, such as the governor pattern, the flowing water pattern, the two sides of the Mekong pattern, and the Pathumthip pattern. There are also hats and keychains of the whale family from the Hin Sam Wan landmark. Those who love earth tone clothes with designs... Dara Nakee is the answer!!!

City of Three Dharmas Mueang Nong Han Luang

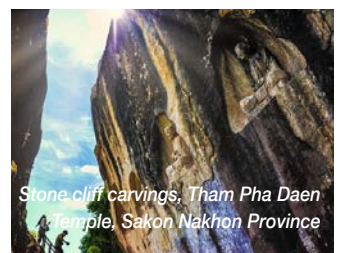

On top there is a large golden stone pagoda that can be seen from a distance, which represents the peak of Mount Phra Sumeru, a sacred and spiritual place. You can study nature in a very chill atmosphere with beautiful views at Nong Han Lake. It is the largest source of freshwater in the northeastern region, which is also a local fishing source, a source for drinking water, and a place of relaxation for the people of Sakon Nakhon.

Not too far away is another landmark in the heart of Bangkok, the “Sao Chingcha” or “Giant Swing”. It can be called as another symbol of Bangkok. Travel a little further to the little corners where you can take chic photos of Bangkok’s colors, a perfect blend of vintage elements and street art in the Charoen Krung area. 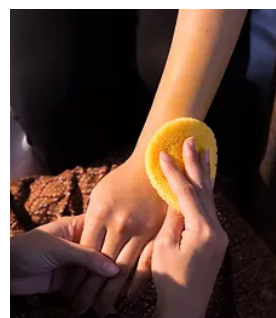

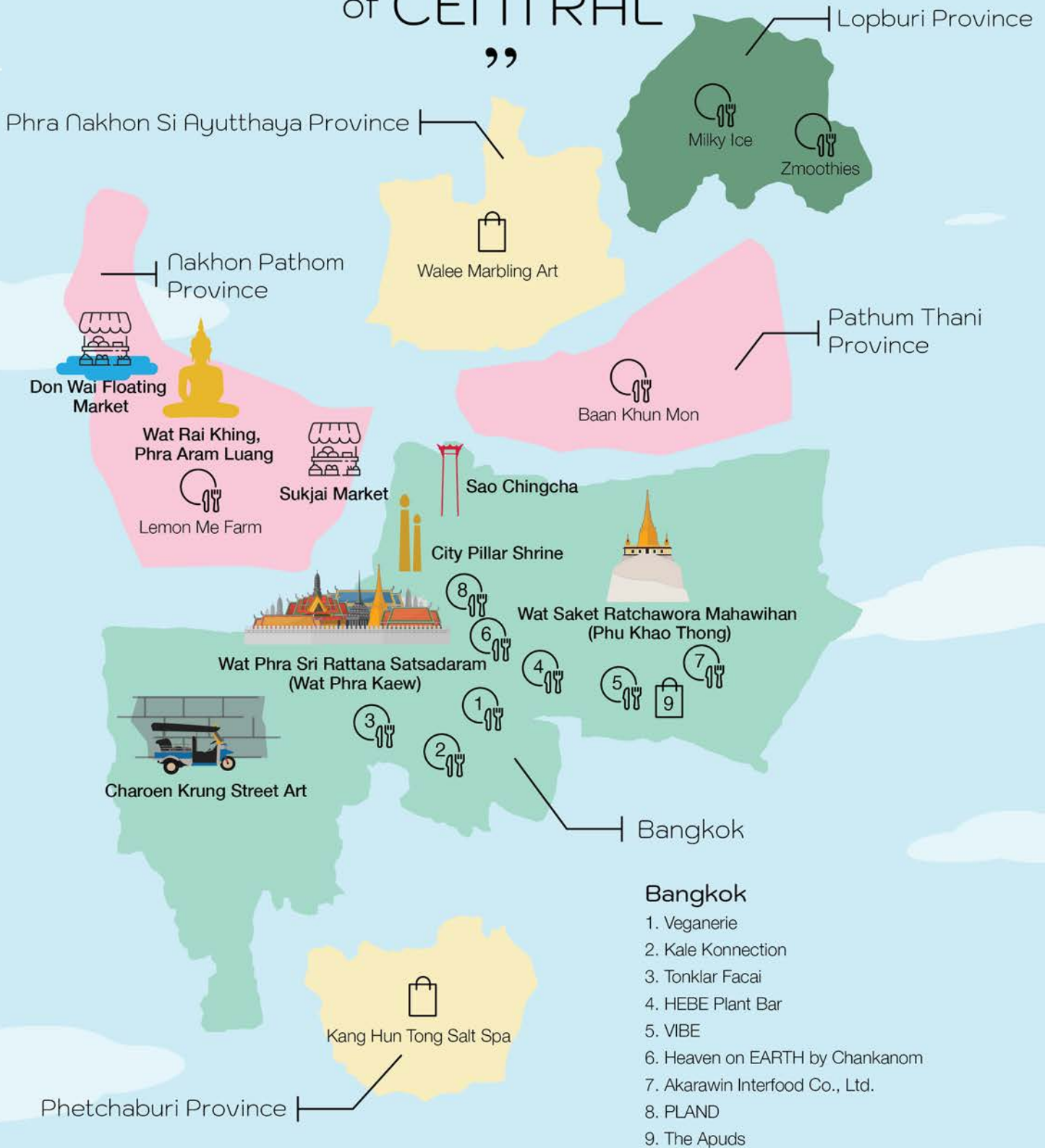

Let’s move on to the mesmerizing Sanctuary of Truth, a magnificent wooden castle by the sea, the largest and most spectacular in Thailand. It is beautifully decorated with sculptures and carved patterns in the Thai Chaturamukha style. More than 100 meters high, it reflects the worldview of wisdom. What makes this place stand out is that they used hardwood that can bear weight well for construction, such as takhianthong wood, padauk wood, red wood, teng wood, and golden teak wood. A contemporary Thai architecture built in the reign of King Rama IX, it was designed to break away from the traditional Thai architectural framework but relied on ancient methods for construction. For example, fastening wood by using dowels, engraving, and dovetail wood joints. They did not use any nails. The main idea is to present beliefs, religion, philosophy, ethics, civilization and the beautiful culture of Southeast Asia. In addition to visiting the beauty of the Sanctuary of Truth, the area around it also has many other activities for you to enjoy, whether it’s riding a horse-drawn carriage, riding an elephant,

driving ATVs around the Sanctuary of Truth, or hiring different types of boats to enjoy the sea. There’s also performances of Thai arts and culture. You can enjoy Thai folk dance, martial arts, Thai dancing, Krabi Krabong (weapon-based martial art), Muay Thai, and dolphin shows all in one place! Most importantly, the Sanctuary of Truth received an award in the Outstanding Tourist Attraction category from the Thailand Tourism Awards in 2008 as well.

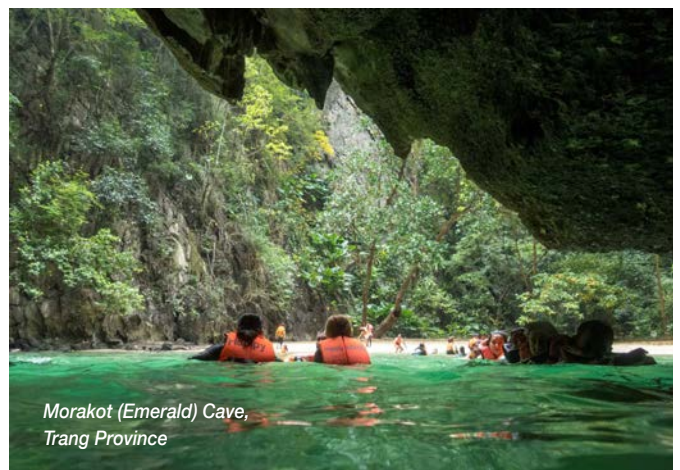
