TA KIEN TIA COMMUNITY, CHONBURI

Have fun on the coconut tourism route with the coconut conservation community.

Take a tour of the coconut conservation community and learn from their local wisdom, from the organic maintenance of the coconut farm to heartwarming art workshops with the locals. Enjoy special meals made using coconuts from the farm and travel back in time to experience the cultural heritage of the community, which was awarded the Silver Award at the 13th Thailand Tourism Awards 2021 by the Tourism Authority of Thailand.

Not far from the bustling city of Pattaya, you can venture a bit further to visit a peaceful community with a unique identity and a strong commitment to conserving coconut-farming areas for educational and cultural tourism purposes. One of the landmarks is a hundred-year-old traditional twin Thai house with hundreds

of poles, which welcomes visitors to learn about the ancient Thai way of life. Activities include making northeastern-style garlands - a hanging decoration with camphor, crafting fresh flower eco printed bags, and painting coconut shells. And don't miss sipping the signature coconut coffee and attending a cooking class to learn how to make soft coconut shell curry with chicken!

Moreover, you can ride a bike along the tour trail to explore the community and beautiful coconut farms such as Saroch and Waew's Forestry Plantation, Fah Sai I-Ko Plantation, and more. You can participate in activities like making tie-dye fabric with colors from coconut coir, observing the process of making cold-pressed coconut oil, or playing disc golf in a shaded area.

- See the hundred-poles house architecture and ancient Thai appliances.
- Join art workshops such as making northeastern-style camphor garlands, fresh-flowers printed bags, coconut shell painting and more.
- Attend a cooking class to make soft coconut shells curry with chicken with the community's chef and sip the soft texture of coconut coffee.
- Have local dishes from the community housewives' recipes for lunch.
- See the cold-pressing method for coconut oil at Saroch and Waew's Forestry Plantation.
- Enjoy playing disc golf at Fah Sai I-Ko plantation.

NONG NOOCH GARDEN, CHONBURI

Asstounded by the diversity of botanical wonders and the creative brilliance within this expansive 6,721-acre botanical garden, acclaimed as one of the most beautiful in the world. Recognized with Gold and Silver Awards at the Thailand Tourism Awards by the Tourism Authority of Thailand for more than five consecutive times, it stands as a premier destination offering relaxation and a myriad of activities across its 50 distinct zones.

Experience the grandeur of over 18,000 varieties of plants and trees across a multitude of garden types: from the cactus garden boasting the most succulent plants in Thailand, to the cycad valley adorned with numerous species of cycads and rare palm trees. Wander through the variegated plants garden, a natural canvas painted by Mother Nature herself, and explore the bonsai garden, herbal garden, tray garden, and more. One of the highlights is the Dinosaur Valley, home to over 400 species of dinosaurs, with over a thousand models meticulously crafted to depict the most realistic scenes from millions of years ago. Hear the deafening roars as you encounter the towering 16-meter-tall Sauroposeidon, the fearsome Carcharodontosaurus, and herds of velociraptors with their razor-sharp claws and teeth. You'll also discover dinosaurs native to Thailand as well.

CHANTHABOON WATERFRONT COMMUNITY, CHANTHABURI

Explore the historic old stores, admire the architectural charm, indulge in making traditional desserts, and delve into gemstone cutting.

Experience the charm of the old Chanthaburi riverfront village, a historic commercial hub of the eastern provinces, with its nostalgic ambiance and well-preserved old-style shophouses dating back to the era of King Rama V, best explored on a leisurely walking tour or a scenic boat cruise along the river.

Apart from the wooden shophouses, some historic homes like Luang Rajamaitri Historic Inn and Punyashtithi Villa offer visitors a chance to explore their rich heritage or even stay overnight, immersed in the riverside ambiance. Religious landmarks such as the gothic Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception and the golden spherical pagoda of Bot Muang temple, along with the grand Chinese-style Tua Lao IA Shrine, add to the architectural diversity of the community.


If you love participating in activities that expose you to the local distinctiveness, there is a workshop for gem cutting for you to learn and try. You can participate in this activity at Baan 119 and Mee Jai Studio. Further, there are activities for you to learn how to make desserts that blend influences from both Thai and Vietnamese, such as Tien Kaew and Ko Yuan. You can try painting Chinese lanterns for your own souvenirs. You can also find signature dishes to taste, such as Salt and Chilli Seasoned Rice, Moo Liang Noodles, Castella cake, and old-school ice cream along the walking street.

BAO PLOY LEK PHET, CHANTHABURI

Experience the life of Chanthaburi miners as you try your hand at traditional gemstone digging to craft your own souvenir.

Explore Chanthaburi in an exciting and immersive way by stepping into the shoes of a gem miner. Learn about the region's geology, including its stratigraphy, and discover the traditional methods of gem mining. Experience the thrill of digging for gems yourself, and use the stones you find to create your very own souvenir.

Embark on a journey through time to explore Chanthaburi's gem mines, which were formed by ancient volcanic eruptions, resulting in an abundance of minerals and gems. Join the quest to uncover the treasures hidden beneath the earth using the traditional tool known as "Plo" to delve into deep ponds to retrieve gemstones and minerals, then engage in the sorting process. Discover unique jasper specimens, which you can take home as souvenirs or have them cut and shaped to enhance their value. Participate in workshops where you can use the gemstones you've found to create personalized souvenirs such as resin pendants, necklaces, or key-rings.

If you're passionate about gemstones from Chanthaburi, indulge in a range of captivating activities. Embark on a hike to collect gemstones scattered on the ground, or unleash your creativity with tie-dye clothes using colors sourced from the clay found in the gem mines. Wander through lush orchards and indulge in fruit-picking (seasonal), see the majestic brahminy kites, explore the tranquility of the mangrove forest and more. Choose from riverfront accommodations nestled among the orchards for a peaceful retreat, or opt for spending the night in a cozy tent.

- Get to know Chanthaburi and the history of its source of gems.
- Go in meters-deep to a gem mine and try digging for gems using "Plo"
- Join in sorting unheated gems and take home the gemstones you excavate as a souvenir.

- Engage in activities such as hiking to collect gemstones, tie-dyeing a shirt with clay colors, and more.
- Relax in a private riverside room nestled among orchards or in a tent.

OLD PHUKET FARM, PHUKET

Wear local attire and engage in rice farming activities, experience mineral panning, and savor delicious dishes made from locally sourced ingredients.

Spend your time being close to nature, breathe in the earthy scents of soil and clay, and experience life as a traditional local resident. Try your hand at mineral panning, reminiscent of the activities of Phuket women during the days when tin mines were still active.

Experience the traditional way of life of Thai farmers, one of the oldest occupations on Phuket Island, including rice cultivation, buffalo farming, and rice processing techniques such as milling and winnowing. While these practices are less common in modern Phuket, they offer insight into the island's agricultural heritage. Next, visit a rubber tree plantation where you can try your hand at rubber tapping

and observe the rubber sheeting process. Then, explore a pineapple farm to taste the unique flavor and texture of Phuket pineapples, including their edible cores. Finally, engage in mineral panning, a historical activity once performed by Phuket women to collect minerals from soil and water, providing them with additional income.

Indulge in authentic Thai cuisine freshly prepared using ingredients grown locally by the community at various restaurants on the island. Additionally, opt for a private cooking class with skilled chefs who will impart valuable tips and tricks for cooking Thai delicacies such as Tom Yum with Shrimp, Pad Thai, steamed banana cake, and more.



Highlighted: "Traditional Way of Life" Activities

- Try mineral panning like the Phuket women back in the days the mines were active.
- Visit rice fields, try cultivating rice, tend buffaloes, as well as observe rice milling and winnowing practices.
- Go to the rubber trees plantation and you can try tapping rubber using a knife as well as seeing the rubber sheeting process.
- Visit the Phuket pineapple plantation to taste the uniquely delicious pineapples, including their edible cores.
- Savor Thai food made from ingredients grown by both restaurants and the local community.
- Join a cooking class with chefs to learn how to make dishes like Tom Yum with Shrimp, Pad Thai, Steamed Banana Cake, and more. (Reservation required)

06 Activities (Local Shopping, Community Based Tourism)

PHUKET OLD TOWN, PHUKET

Experience low-carbon travel by wearing local attire as you explore the old town, visit the museum, and savor delicious local dishes.

Stroll along and admire the Sino-Portuguese architecture and discover the cultural charm of “Peranakan,” a blend of Chinese, Malay, and Thai influences. Participate in local activities to gain new experiences while practicing low-pollution travel in a renowned attraction that won the Gold Awards in Community Tourism and the Silver Awards in Low-Carbon Tourism for Sustainability at the 14th Thailand Tourism Awards 2023 by the Tourism Authority of Thailand.

Wear the Peranakan traditional attire and stroll through the old city, where you can choose from an openwork-lace shirt paired with a Patae sarong for women, or The Miner suit in Khaki with a topee hat for men. Explore unique shophouses, local buildings with shops on the first floor and accommodations on upper floors. You’ll find restaurants, local grocery shops, and old printing houses, while some have been renovated into cafes, hostels, or museums. One interesting museum is the Moh Seng Museum, which exhibits the commerce and way of life of the locals from the old days. Additionally, visit Baan 92, which offers cooking workshops for Hokkien Styled Fried Noodles, Ang Ku -- an important dish for the Por Tor festival, and the crispy Ah Pong.

On Sunday nights, you can visit the “Lad Yai” walking street, where you’ll admire beautifully lit architecture and experience the vibrant atmosphere of stalls selling Phuket foods like O-Tao, Lo-Ba, Fresh Spring Rolls, and O-Aew. You’ll also find stalls selling handmade goods, postcards, and some offering on-site portrait drawing. Additionally, enjoy watching vintage bands performing live music.

PHUKET THAI HUA MUSEUM, PHUKET

Admire centuries-old architecture and get to know the people of Phuket better.

Explore the cultural world and experience the story of the Hokkien ancestors who traveled across the ocean from the Fujian district to settle on Phuket island. This is the birthplace of the Peranakan culture and many other inheritances that have been passed down from older generations to present-day Phuket people.

Experience the reverent ambiance exuding from the centuries-old Sino-Portuguese architecture adorned with a bat spreading wings symbol on the facade. Initially, this place was the first Chinese language school in Phuket and later became a museum. Visitors will have the chance to learn more about



The Phuket people dating back to the ancestral generations who migrated from China, settled here, and blended with the locals to become the mixed Peranakan or Baba Yaya. The museum also tells the story of the tin mines, the evolution of house-building from using wood and palm leaves to cement and bricks in the Sino-Portuguese style. It showcases the history of many important people, including Phraya Ratsadanupradit Mahitsaraphakdi (Khaw Sim Bee), as well as the way of life, wisdom, traditions, attire, food, etc., through exhibitions in 14 rooms.

Moreover, you can check the Phuket Thai Hua Museum schedule each year to attend the yearly Baba Yaya wedding (locally known as “Pang Teh”), visit the museum at night, and explore local goods sales or cultural performances at each opportunity.

- Admire the historical site and its bat spreading wing’s symbol decoration.
- Discover the meaning and roots of the Baba Yaya people.
- Get to know the tin mines, the original source of income for people in Phuket.
- Travel back in time to the birth of Sino-Portuguese architecture in Phuket.
- See the Baba Yaya wedding, night museums, and other activities.
- Shop for T-shirts, mugs, tote bags with the museum symbols on it, as well as surname key rings.

BAAN CHINPRACHA, PHUKET

Admire one of the few Sino-Portuguese buildings in Phuket and participate in cooking a local signature dish.

Travel back to the last century to experience the cultural richness, way of living, traditions, and values of Phuket people in the old days by visiting “Ang Mo Lao,” a luxurious Sino-Portuguese building of Phra Pithakchinpracha (Tan Ma Sieng), the late prosperous merchant of Phuket.

Chinpracha House is one of the old manors that has been preserved and turned into a museum. Visitors will get to see the blended art between European and Chinese influences, from the Italian tiles that pave the floors to the Chinese marquetry table sets. The house features a Chim Jae, an open space in the middle of the house designed to allow natural light to enter. Additionally, visitors can observe items that depict Phuket’s way of living in

the past, such as the old-style kitchen equipped with a worship center for the Fire god and traditional crockery. Visitors can even wear Baba bridal dresses and “Hua Guan,” or flower tiaras, along with other beautiful accessories, to take pictures in this graceful manor.

There is also an exclusive cooking class that teaches how to cook Hokkien Styled Fried Noodles, a signature dish influenced by the Hokkien people who settled in Phuket. The main ingredient is the large yellow rice noodles, symbolizing longevity, so they need to be cooked carefully to avoid tearing them apart. Participants can try their hand at making Ang Ku, a dessert with a bean filling wrapped in red dough and molded into a turtle shape. This is a must-have dessert used in many important rituals.

- See the uniqueness and beliefs in the old-timey kitchen and learn about Sia Na.
- Wear Baba bridal dress with flower tiaras and take a photo in the classic manor.
- Join a cooking class to learn how to prepare Hokkien Styled Fried Noodles and Ang Ku (for groups of up to 20 people with reservations only).

SITAO STUDIO, PHUKET

Unleash your creativity and inspiration through clay molding and painting.

Not far from the Chartered Bank intersection, a popular photo spot in the old town, you'll find a cafe and ceramics studio or painting art with a minimalist vibe housed in an old Sino-Portuguese style building painted in a striking yellow color.

You can dedicate anywhere from 1-2 hours or more to your artwork, depending on your ideas and preferences. Additionally, the cafe offers wrapping and shipping services to deliver your art worldwide.

Experience the unaltered way of life in the old community of Phuket Island, nestled amidst the sea and mountains. Enjoy activities rooted in traditional practices, all while committing to the mission of emitting less pollution into the environment. This community serves as a model for CBT Smart Environment recognized by the Department of Tourism, Ministry of Tourism and Sports.

Bang Rong people open their community for tourism, offering local guides who will assist you in exploring and collecting interesting experiences. Your journey begins with a welcome drink, Pineapple Tea, followed by a Patae or Batik tote bag painting activity aimed at replacing plastic bags. Next, a wooden car will transport you to the Phuket Pineapple farm, registered as a geographical indication (GI). Here, you can taste

the sweet and delightful texture of the pineapples, including their edible cores, and shop for pineapple-based products such as chili paste, soaps, and lotion. Moreover, you can participate in a rubber-tapping activity, where you'll learn to make an incision on the trunk of a rubber tree and collect the white liquid that seeps out. Additionally, you can join a trip to catch Dollfus' octopus with shells, a local tradition, or engage in activities to sustain nature such as building fish houses, releasing crabs, planting mangrove forests, and more.

For food enthusiasts, Bang Rong also offers a fun cooking workshop where you can gather ingredients such as coconuts from the trees and make Ko, a dessert that pairs well with sweet coconut juice. Alternatively, you can opt for a special experience like the Chef's Table, featuring dishes made from local ingredients.

THE BIG BUDDHA, PHUKET

Visit the landmark to pay homage to the biggest Buddha statue on Phuket and admire the landscape from a 360-degree vantage point.

Be blessed by Phra Phutta Ming Mongkol Eknakiri, the white marble Buddha statue situated on the Nak Kerd mountaintop. From there, you can admire every aspect of the town zone and beach zone, as well as the landscape from a high-angle vantage point, making it one of the most beautiful places to visit.

Pay homage to the spiritual anchor of the Phuket people at the Buddha statue, depicting the attitude of subduing Mara. This contemporary art-style statue measures 25.45 meters in width and 45 meters in height, making it the biggest and highest Buddha statue on Phuket. Admire the beauty of the statue adorned with white marble. Additionally,

you can find famous monk statues such as Monk Luang Phu Suang and Monk Luang Phu Waen. In the shady park surrounding the statue, various kinds of animals cohabit peacefully. Visitors are also welcomed to learn about Buddhist philosophy, meditate, and pray in the evening.

With its excellent location, this site offers an impressive vantage point at any time of the day. In front of the statue, you can enjoy views of Chalong Bay with boats anchored, the town area, and lush greenery. Behind the statue, you'll be treated to sights of Ka Ta Beach, Ka Ron Beach, the expansive deep blue sea, and the surrounding islands.

Let your imagination free while painting on coconut shells as souvenirs. Learn to make ancient mobiles such as Puang Mahot to contain camphor. Taste the aromatic coconut coffee with flavorful coconut milk.

Another highlight of the Takien Tia Community is the cooking class where you will be making chicken curry in a coconut shell with the community chef using the young coconut shell from the farm. You will be learning the secret and delicacy of cooking Thai curry. Then enjoy the food in a warm

circle just like the locals do. The Takien Tia Community prides itself in conserving its coconut farming lifestyle and is guaranteed by the Silver Awards from Thailand Tourism Awards 13th in 2021 by the Tourism Authority of Thailand.

If you have time, continue your journey to Chanthaburi Province to experience the charm of the past at the Chanthaboon Waterfront Community. Admire the architectural beauty of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, participate in a jewelry workshop, try making desserts like Tien Kaew and Ko Yuan, and more. Alternatively, you can learn about the way of life of the miners in the city of Chanthaburi at the Bao Ploy Lek Phet. approved as a Geographical Indications. Taste the freshly peeled, crisp, fragrance, and sweet to the core as well as juice and dessert from Phuket's pineapple. Filling up just enough before heading on to learn the southern way of rubber tapping and rubber sheet-making. Before heading on to a coconut farm to learn the ancient way of coconut picking as well as Cooking Workshops such as making fresh coconut milk, tasting the community's dessert and local lunch while enjoying the scenery at the Bang Rong's port.

If time permits for a whole-day trip, a longtail boat trip is available to take you to

learn about coast fishing, witness, and learn to catch octopus using shells. Discover the lifestyle of the local Thai-Muslim community, deeply connected to nature and committed to its preservation. They thrive on age-old wisdom and crafts that reflect their unique identity.

This community is renowned for its cultural tourism aspect. Visitors can gain insight into traditional Islamic teachings at Pondok Krudia and experience the way locals make a living. This includes cruising to observe traditional squid fishing (Sai Muek), visiting rubber plantations, trying rubber-tapping and learning about cup lumps production, discovering goat-keeping in the Islamic tradition, crafting with coconut shells, trying their hand at painting Batik fabric, a unique local material used for clothing, scarves, and bags. Additionally, visitors can learn about the production of pineapple fiber paper and the crafting of long-tail boat prows.

The community is surrounded by a mangrove forest ecosystem, serving as a nursery ground for aquatic animals and an educational source to learn about black crabs. Additionally, visitors can witness demonstrations of local food and dessert cooking, such as Toom Prong, Jaak, and more. They can also observe the traditional process of juicing sugar canes and the roasting process for Krabi's coffee beans.

On weekends, the Pra Teen market offers an opportunity to shop for goods and taste local foods in a sylvan environment. Visitors can also contribute to reducing the impact of global warming by using natural food containers. Furthermore, various entertaining shows are available at the market.

BAAN NAI NANG COMMUNITY-BASED TOURISM, KRABI

Indulge in the abundance of nature while learning about agricultural practices, Indian honey bee farming, and fishery management.

The Baan Nai Nang community is hidden amidst the abundance of Krabi's natural resources. The locals lead peaceful and simple lives, which align with the idea of nature preservation. However, they warmly welcome visitors to experience the fullest extent of happiness through various creative tourist activities, ranging from agriculture to bee farming and fishery management.

Most areas in the community are planted with rubber trees, allowing visitors to admire the plantations and try tapping rubber themselves. Additionally, visitors can explore natural bee farms within the plantation. Participate in a soap workshop where you can make soap from honey, which helps moisturize your skin. Engage in activities such as separating bee larvae into bamboo cans to breed them and contribute to balancing nature. Visitors can also shop for honey products and visit the Kok Nong Na educational center, where the concept of a "sufficiency economy" has been applied in the model.

Moreover, visitors can observe the fishery and natural preservation efforts in the area, including the operation of the flower crab bank and blue swimming crab farming. These initiatives involve breeding crabs to release them into nature. Additionally, don't miss out on long-tail boat trips to admire the grandeur of nature in the middle of the sea. Explore attractions such as the Evil Face cliff, formed by million-year-long erosion, ancient cliff paintings on Karos cliff, and kayaking through mountain passes to capture never-before-seen views.

Experience the blend of three cultures and discover new things by participating in activities with the locals.



“The land of three shores where the three cultures blend” is the definition of the location and its inhabitants, who are Thai Buddhists, ethnic Chinese, and Thai Muslims. They hold different and unique identities yet reside together in this small community peacefully. This community has been selected as a BCG Model by the Ministry of Commerce and has received Gold and Silver Awards in Community Tourism at the Thailand Tourism Awards from the Tourism Authority of Thailand more than three times.

Hop on a long-tail boat to see the farming of painted spiny lobsters, groupers, sea bass, and sea grapes, which are valuable products of the sea. You will also get to see the limestone hills landscape and visit the 3,000-year-old seaman cave with ancient cave paintings. After that, hop off and see the community's landmark: Blue House architecture. Enjoy its Cooking Class to learn how to cook the Aung Goo (a Baba Yaya dessert recipe) and the chewy Go Sui, which is mostly eaten with shredded coconut. Visit a religious place within walking distance such as Mahathat Laem Sak Temple, Sok Po Si Ea Shrine, and others, as well as participate in planting trees on the seashore. Also, don't miss the Batik Painting activity to make your own souvenir.

Before leaving, you can also shop for goods from the community, such as Batik, contemporary-design Patae trousers, Baba Yaya attire, and skincare products made from sea grapes that help preserve the skin's moisture. The highlight is the processed seafood products made in a traditional and non-chemical way, such as shrimp paste, dried fish, and many more.

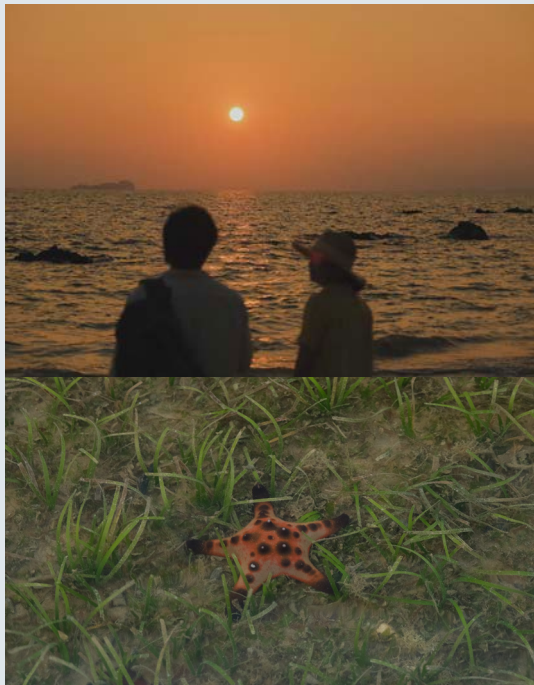
